#### **FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

#### **UNDERSTANDING THE MASS**

THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST: This is the part of the Mass where the Sacred Scripture comes alive in a very special way. It is where Calvary is made 'present' at each Mass as we go 'outside of time' to the moment of Christ's passion, death and resurrection. This is not a history lesson, it is not recreating Christ's passion; he died once for all people and all time. God lifts us up to His throne during the Mass, and we are able to receive Him at Holy Communion.

PRESENTATION OF THE GIFTS: This is present bread and wine for the sacrifice of the Mass. It is also normally the time we take up a collection and present these gifts as well. The offering is more than something we do to keep the lights on, it is deciding what we will offer to God. Do we offer our 'first fruits', or do we offer what is left over? Although the Church does not require tithes, offering a tithe is a way to ensure we are offering first fruits and not left-over's. Along with our gifts of treasure, bread and wine are offered as well as our prayers, our joys and our trials. When the bread and wine are lifted up, we are lifting the entire parish, the lives of each member, up to God. Water and wine are then mixed in the chalice; the wine symbolizing Christ's divinity and the water symbolizing Christ's humanity. This reminds us that God humbled himself and took on humanity, and we are invited to partake in his divinity. Following this is the ceremonial washing of the priest's hands, when the priest quietly prays from Psalm 51: Lord wash away my iniquity and cleanse me of my sin, calling to mind that he is a sinful creature in need of God's

**PREFACE** The Lord be with you; Lift up your hearts; Let us give thanks to the Lord: we are so familiar with these prayers the response can be almost automatic. But what do they really signify? We have just offered the entirety of our lives; now we are giving God permission to do as He desires with our offering; to take our lives, to break them and remake them in him. Do we realize what we are praying? Do we mean what we are praying?

SANCTUS, SANCTUS, SANCTUS: The Holy, Holy, prayer is found in Sacred Scripture, in both the new and old testament. This is pure worship, joining our voices to those of the angels and saints in heaven giving God praise.

EPICLESIS: This is a Greek term meaning 'to call down', and is a prayer calling down the Holy Spirit upon the altar and the gifts. It is a prayer for the transformation of the gifts and for the transformation of all gathered for that particular Mass.


CONSECRATION: This is the moment in the Liturgy of the Eucharist when the bread and wine, through the words of Jesus Christ, spoken by the ministerial priest, become his body and blood. The gifts are raised, and accompanied in many churches with the ringing of bells, signifying the importance of what is occurring at this particular moment.

DOXOLOGY /GREAT AMEN: At the conclusion of the Eucharistic Prayer, the priest proclaims the doxology... Through him, with him, in him... while elevating the host and chalice. What was bread and wine are now the body and blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ; our savior and redeemer. Recognition of this fact leads us to affirm in one voice; AMEN! (I believe) This prayer is said by the entire congregation, and is more than the conclusion of the rite; it is an affirmation of all that has just been prayed. This Amen is the entire body joining in the prayer the priest has just recited and prayed, and is the most important response of all the Mass. This is not a private, personal moment, but a public communal expression of our faith in Christ and our love for him, and is meant to be prayed aloud.
