MISSION SUPPORT 2021:

The Catholic Church is a missionary church, that is, we strive to assist the spreading of the Gospel throughout the world. Pope Emeritus Benedict once wrote concerning missions: "The universal mission involves all, all things and always. The Gospel is not the exclusive possession of whoever has received it but as gift to share, good news to communicate. And this gift commitment is not entrusted to a few but on the contrary to all the baptized." For most of us, that means that we support financially those who have given their lives to this mission rather than physically going to areas of the world that is in need of Gospel teachings.


