

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

MORE FROM ARCHBISHOP SHEEN

Last week I shared with you a challenge Archbishop Fulton Sheen pointed to over 45 years ago, on how Christendom was fading away even then, and has continued sliding downhill through our own day, and how this has been a cycle humanity has faced since before the time of Christ. When Moses sent the leaders of his people to reconnoiter the Promised Land, all the military leaders except Caleb and Joshua were frightened of those that occupied the territory. Joshua and Caleb gave a 'minority report', which was blessed by God, proving that often times a majority, even a majority that is aggressive and troublemaking, is not always right. In addition, there is often a silent aspect of society that can even constitute a majority. Sheen warns that the faithful sisters, priests, bishops and laity will seem to be a minority, but these will be the faithful that trust in God in all things.

He went on: "Not far after our time, and perhaps in the time of some, then will come the battles and the testing. Our Lord said Satan would sift you as wheat. And we are being sifted as wheat. So we can all thank God that we live in these days. Really, it's beautiful. Now we can say, 'aye' or 'nay,' and we can bear up under assault, criticism and ridicule, because this is the lot of the Christian in the days of the spirit of the world."

Sheen is encouraged because "it is a picture of the Church in the midst of increasing opposition from the world. And, therefore, live your lives in the full consciousness of this hour of testing, and rally close to the heart of Christ." Be the "minority." He reminds us the Kingdom of God suffers violence and the violent take it by force. He observed how when the Church drops things, the world picks them up but twists them in the wrong way. For example, mysticism drops, and the young turn to drugs.

"And we drop violence, discipline, commitment to the Cross, and the world picks it up. That's why there's no stopping the violence of this country. The world's answer to violence is to hire more police guards or build more hospitals for the addicts. Why? Because there's no moral reason on the inside why they should stop." We may speak of peace, but peace will not reign in our world until peace reigns in our hearts. Peace will not reign in our hearts until we go to war with ourselves; using the sword of the Lord to cut out the seven pallbearers of the soul: pride, covetousness, lust, anger, envy, gluttony and sloth. And we've given up the sword — someone else has taken it up, and we have to restore it! Then we'll get peace! And peace is never corporate — it is never social — until it is first individual.

Social peace or world peace is the extension of individual peace in our hearts. When we are right with God, then we will be right with our fellow man. When we are not right with God, then we will be wrong with everyone else." Archbishop Sheen encourages everyone to take seriously spending an hour before the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament every day "not only for our own souls, but for the world, and to strengthen our minority." He tells us: "The Lord is keeping reserves. He is training us. We'll make the entry. We'll prepare for a new Church. And he is with us — we just simply can't add rules — only we've already won as a matter of fact, only the news has not yet leaked out — and so it's violence that has to be restored."
