#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### HOW TO COUNTER CANCEL CULTURE

We are in a battle, and it is a battle for individual souls and for the soul of this great nation. This war is currently centered around what has become known as Cancel Culture, but it is a war that has been raging for some time, although under different names, and will morph again into something else, as it is a way driven by Satan, whom we all know is the great deceiver or liar. I was sent an article on how Catholic education (C.E.), whether it is received in the form of a Catholic school or other faith formation, either aimed at young people or adults, can be a weapon for engaging in this battle.

- C.E. is rooted in the truth, and the end game is the salvation of souls. The following are summarized from the Newman's Society Principals of Catholic Identity, Catholic Curriculum Standards and Catholic Educations Call in the Face of Cancel Culture by Dr Dan Guernsey and Dr. Denise Donohue:
- C. E. embraces a Catholic worldview, where faith and culture enrich and speak to each other, and always lead with Jesus.

Proper C. E. uses faithful Catholic materials, being wary of speakers, materials or programs that deny or undermine Catholic teaching including blaming one particular group for all the ills of humanity or seeks vengeance or stifling of religious freedoms.

Promotes a clear Christian anthropology and Catholic understanding of the human person. This affirms our being created as male and female, in the image and likeness of God, and the union of our body and spirit. We also acknowledge that we are made by God and for God.

Discussions are in relation to Catholic social teaching, including the dignity of all human persons and the sacredness of human life, the sanctity of marriage and how this relates to human society and human fraternity amid national, racial, ethnic, economic, gender and ideological differences.

C.E. helps us discover the religious dimension throughout human history. This compares the actions of persons according to Catholic morality and virtues and looks at the development of the person or culture according to the conditions, understanding and knowledge of the time.

The morality of human acts can be analyzed, including separating the sin and the sinner. The degree of individual culpability is based on individual awareness and freedom, not on generalizations of group behaviors, and includes possibilities of repentance and forgiveness.

Logic and reason are taught and used to uncover objective truth, and promotes dialogue as a means of pursuing truth and unity.

The discussions are governed by Catholic values, including charity, forgiveness, mercy, justice and the common good. Music, art, movies and literature are means utilized to emphasize with another's suffering without a direct experience.

Compounding tensions and divisions are avoided by turning from blood language, including politically charged terms and symbols that lack nuance, have distinct meanings for separate groups, avoids an 'all in' approach to complex social flashpoints of emphasizes political power of conflict. Carefully defines terms within a Catholic context and vocabulary.

C. E. avoids replacing academic pursuits with activism and allowing curricula to be driven by the news cycle. C. E. does not force students into protests, compel them to identify with morally ranked categories, or require activities to make them feel the pain of discrimination.

These are the basic foundations we all need to rely upon regarding a Catholic education for ourselves and for our children. Following these, we do not avoid the truth about man and God, but rather embrace the truth in order to forge a path through relativism and other attacks of modernity that scourge our world today. Pray for our teachers and catechists.


