FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

FORMED

As you noticed in the bulletin last week, FORMED is once again available to our parishioners and Columbus School teachers. The reason it was down for a couple weeks was due to a doubling of the subscription for a year. We are pleased to make this available once again, and encourage any that wish to take advantage of this subscription to do so. There are many good family movies available to stream, as well as a variety of formation programs that are offered. Thank you to all those that let me know how much this is appreciated in your homes and in our school.

MAGNIFICAT LENTEN REFLECTION BOOKS

Once again we will offer Lenten Daily Reflection books for your use. These will be available the weekend of Feb 26 & 27 for families to pick up. They will remain until all have been taken. Additionally, we will have a children's series available at the same times.

LENTEN PRACTICES

In order to get a great start on Lent, it is necessary to begin preparations in advance of Ash Wednesday. If we neglect advance preparations until Ash Wednesday, we will find ourselves spinning our wheels at the start of Lent. By preparing in advance, we can be ready to begin the season of Lent spiritually armed for the battle we know we will face. I would like to challenge you to not simply try to do the same thing as last year (or the last 20 years). Find a new path and challenge and take this to prayer, asking God for direction on what He desires to change in our lives.

In order to begin our preparations, I offer some words of St. Francis De Sales on fasting:

To treat fasting and of what is required to fast well, we must, at the start, understand that of itself fasting is not a virtue. The good and the bad, as well as Christians and pagans, observe it. The ancient philosophers observed it and recommended it. They were not virtuous for that reason, nor did they practice virtue in fasting. Oh, no, fasting is a virtue only when it is accompanied by conditions which render it pleasing to God. Thus it happens that it profits some and not others, because it is not undertaken by all in the same manner.

We find some people who think that to fast well during the holy season of Lent it is enough to abstain from eating some prohibited food. But this thought is too gross to enter into the hearts of religious, for it is to you I speak, as well as persons dedicated to Our Lord. We know very well that it is not enough to fast exteriorly if we do not also fast interiorly and if we do not accompany the fast of the body with that of the spirit.


