It is so very good to be here at St. John's! I am looking forward to meeting everyone. This past week, I was able to move into the rectory. My parents came over from Clear Lake and helped me with much of the moving process. Still lots to rearrange but feel super blessed to be here. Last Friday's tractor pull was such a great way to meet so many of you! It was a wonderful way to connect and to begin my assignment here at St. John's!

This weekend we hear of the charity of the Good Samaritan. This parable comes directly after the answer from the scribe who correctly said, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself."

The Nicene Creed is a powerful statement of our faith. However, its importance goes beyond just an intellectual assent of the truths or our faith. The word 'creed' is directly connected to the word heart. Do a quick Google search on the origin of this word and you will see this connection. Our faith as Catholics is one that involves both our mind and our heart, our intellect and our will. It involves the fullness of our person. Therefore, the words in today's Gospel from the scholar to whom Jesus is speaking are very correct. We must love God with all our heart, all our being, all our strength and all our mind. Charity to our neighbor flows from a deep and full love of God.

"The Words of Jesus are Spirit and Life." (Jn 6:63). "Jesus is the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Him." (Jn 14:6). When we give ourselves fully to Christ and his Church, we have more life. Life is not diminished by our Christianity but is radically filled in Christ. Avoid taking shortcuts and making compromises with your faith. Be dedicated to your faith. Pray daily, receive the sacraments, live charity. This is the path to the abundance of life.

Charity is such a hallmark of our faith. We are called to be a Good Samaritan to everyone. I look forward to the many days and months ahead as I begin to meet each of you. May we each seek with all our heart, all our being, all our strength and all our mind to love God. In doing this we will both love God and neighbor, we will encounter the fire of God's own Divine love and support one another as the Good Samaritan cared for the man who fell victim to robbers. Blessings to each of you.
