FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Thank you for your wonderful welcome these past few weeks. It has truly helped me so much in my transition. All is going well. Bit-by-bit I am trying to learn each of your names. On my desk, I have the picture directory from 2016 open. This has been a great help! I look forward to knowing each of you more and more.

As I meet many of you, I am introduced to the numerous small faith sharing groups that exist in our parish. Our Lord says, "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." (Matt 18:20) Small groups nurture and strengthen the graces received in liturgy. It is wonderful to see so many small groups thriving in our midst.

As many of you know the speaker system in our church was damaged by lightning. Audio Architects is working with us to improve the system. If they are able to repair the current speaker, things will return to normal within a month or so. If an entirely new speaker is needed, the wait-time may be up to 8 months due to the international delays related to shipping. In the meantime, we will continue to work with a temporary speaker system that Audio Architects installed and do our best to finetune the sound.

This weekend St. Paul offers one of the more perplexing lines of Scripture. He says, "Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I am filling up what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ." (Col 1:24). The offering of Jesus on the Cross is perfect. Jesus lacked nothing in His death on the Cross. However, God's wisdom permits us to share in everything he does. This includes his suffering. One may ask, 'How can I rejoice in my suffering? How can my suffering be a source of joy?'

The word sacrifice originates from two words (sacra / facere) meaning (to do / a sacred thing). When we perform a voluntary sacrifice, such as fasting, we give up a momentary pleasure for the purpose of doing a sacred thing. In a spiritual sense fasting empties us of an earthly attachment so that we can be filled with God. Sacrifices are always voluntary. Suffering, however, is forced upon us. They come in all different types of intensities from the most difficult martyrdom, to a terrible flu you've endured for days, to a small headache. However, each suffering we endure can become a sacred offering. They can be a (sacra / facere) a (doing of a sacred thing). These holy offerings are sacred because they are acts of love. Just as a mother or father would offer everything for the healing of their child, it is our deep love of Jesus that urges us on to make holy offerings of our lives. We give all to Jesus, because we gaze upon his crucified body and wish with all our being to alleviate his suffering, to join our suffering with His. It is this union of our sufferings with his sufferings, this exchange of love, the font of all true joy, that yields the exquisite joy of which St Paul speaks. "Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake..." Blessings to each of you this coming week.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.
