FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This weekend is our parish picnic. Thank you to the many people who have helped in organizing, volunteering and serving to make this special day happen. It takes a lot of work, but it is a blessing to share time together and to deepen old friendships and to make new ones. One of my goals in the coming months is to create opportunities for families in our parish to get to know one another. At times in our culture it can feel like we are fighting the fight alone. However, here at St. John the Baptist we are blessed with lots of families and by coming together in friendship in Christ, we will be strengthened in our witness of the faith. It is such a blessing to have so many children at Mass. This witness not only gives us who are older hope of a bright future, but it also provides our youngest parishioners the opportunities to form good and solid friendships.

I hope to be at the picnic in the later part of the afternoon. However, this weekend I will be covering all of the Masses in Dorchester and Abbotsford. Most summers I celebrate Mass in various parishes for mission appeal in support of Chalice of Mercy. The founder of Chalice of Mercy, Valentyna Pavsyukova, joins in these appeals and shares her testimony in support of Ukraine. The war in Ukraine has been a terrible tragedy. Even this week numerous civilians experienced death and the most horrendous of injuries. Since the war began about six months ago, our mission of Chalice of Mercy has shipped over 300 pallets of supplies to Ukraine. Rochester Mayo has been a huge benefactor of supplies - providing outdated but still very valuable medical products and emergency aid. Recently we have also teamed up with a Minnesota based non-profit and have provided a number of prosthetic limbs for both soldiers and civilians. Just a week ago a young 9-year-old boy was provided with a new prosthetic arm.* He lost his arm while his father gave his life shielding his son from an incoming rocket. These and many more efforts of Chalice of Mercy can be seen on our Facebook page. Some of the stories have even been picked up by the TV stations in the Twin Cities. May we continue to pray for peace in Ukraine and in the whole world. ~ Blessings to each of you this coming week.
