FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This Sunday I will be installed as pastor of St. John the Baptist. It is such a deep blessing to be here and to be named pastor. A number of my former parishioners have come by for a visit. They are truly touched by the beauty of our church, the great attendance at Mass, the numerous children in our pews, the multitude of small groups and the greatest gift of perpetual adoration. It is such an honor and blessing to be your pastor.

Our readings this weekend speak much about humility. Humility is the mother of all virtues. St. Gregory the Great and St. Augustine considered humility the pivotal virtue upon which all other virtues depend.

Humility is seeing ourselves as God sees us. It is seeing ourselves as a beautiful son or daughter of the Most Merciful Father. Humility is not lowering ourselves or demeaning ourselves. Rather humility is simply an honest understanding of ourselves. Humility respects our dignity and reflects the great goodness in which we are created.

The Devil is the great manipulator. He is always trying to build up our ego to then shatter us in despair. It is said that St. John Vianney overheard the Devil say to him, "I can do everything you do, I can do your penances, I can imitate you in everything. There is one thing, however, that I cannot do, I cannot imitate you in humility."

Humility is the mark of true holiness. A thoughtprovoking question for a priest is: "Am I weak enough to be a priest? Can I empty myself and be filled with the Holy Spirit?" This same question can be asked by anyone. "Am I weak enough to be a follower of Jesus? Can I empty myself and be filled with the Holy Spirit?"

In the *Diary of the Country Priest* a man states to the priest, "Your simplicity is a kind of flame which scorches them." Humility is a fiery ember. If you are humble, your life is like a fiery torch passing through the world. The Devil flees and evil is set at bay. Choose humility. Choose the cross. Choose obedience. Choose penance. These hallmarks of our faith are the spiritual armaments that protect us on this pilgrimage of earthly existence. (Eph 6:14) With this humility, then choose to love profoundly. Humility is the foundation upon which authentic and saintly love exists.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.
