FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I want to bring two things to your attention this week. First of all, we will be restarting another session of Evangelical Catholic this Fall. Our parish has been working with Evangelical Catholic for almost 6 years and this has been the spark for the many small groups we have in our parish. The program prepares a person for discipleship and assists a parish in launching and sustaining movements of evangelization. In short it answers the question, "How did Jesus bring people to conversion?" The program will equip you with the tools that Jesus used. Thus, with the help of God's grace, allowing you to be the catalyst to draw people back to the faith, perhaps even your fallen away children, by awakening within you a call to discipleship and a desire to participate in evangelization as Christ himself demonstrated in the Gospels.

The first meeting for Evangelical Catholic will be on Thursday, September 22nd at 6:30pm in the St. Francis Room. The program will continue for the following 12 Thursdays (apart from Thanksgiving) and conclude before Christmas. Please give the parish office a call at least a week in advance if you plan to participate. We will need to know an estimate of how many will come. Whether you are married or single, young or old, I hope you can join.

The second topic to share is the capital campaign that was begun last Spring by Fr Weighner. Brochures describing the campaign remain in the back of the church. As you may remember the campaign will support both parish and diocesan needs. The monies collected for the parish will cover the costs of our new garage and the resurfacing of our parking lot. Monies will also be used for the support of Columbus Catholic School and their plans for physical expansion to accommodate their growing enrollment. The exact details of how the monies of the campaign will be used are available in the brochures located in the back of the church. We will also plan to host a couple receptions later this Fall to describe the campaign. Thank you for the many people who have already made a pledge towards the campaign. We are currently at 55% pledged or our goal of 1.17 million.

Speaking of school, it has been wonderful seeing our St John's school bustling with children. We are near max capacity – having around 250 children in the school. Wednesday was the first school Mass and it was amazing seeing our church almost completely filled by children and their teachers!! Thank you to the many teachers who are guiding our children. Please pray for them and for their year of teaching. ~ Blessings to each of you this coming week.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.
