FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I want to congratulate our students who received the Sacrament of Confirmation this Saturday! May we all pray for each of them. May they be filled with the power of the Holy Spirit and endowed with His 7 gifts. The Holy Spirit comes under the symbols of fire and wind. When we live a life of faith in obedience to God, the sacrament of Confirmation bears fruit. These fruits are known as the 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit. They reveal the goodness and the nature of God.

This next Saturday, September 24th, at 6pm we will host at St. John's a special devotion to the Holy Face of Jesus. Jesus says, "Whoever has seen me has seen the Father." (Jn 14:9) To gaze upon the face of Jesus is a holy practice. In my next bulletin column, I plan to share further about this beautiful tradition. I have visited 100's of shrines to saints, most of the world's Marian apparition sites, and even the Holy Land – but a pilgrimage to a small Italian city, the site of the face of Jesus (Veronica's veil), remains one of my most graced experiences. I will share more in the next column.

Thank you to everyone who has made a pledge towards the campaign for the support of our diocese and our parish. During a Mass in October, I will update everyone briefly on the campaign. We will also have two light receptions, Oct 4th & Oct 11th, for those who have further questions. The campaign director has communicated to me that since our pledges to date have already fulfilled our commitment to the Diocesan Annual Appeal, our parish of St. John's will receive 80% of all future pledges, the remainder being used for the support of the diocese. 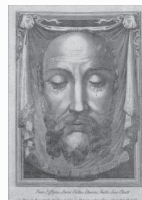

The Holy Face of Jesus Holy Relic Devotion

There will be an opportunity to attend a beautiful presentation for those who wish to learn about this Holy Devotion and show veneration to an actual Holy Face of Jesus. Each attendee will receive a Holy Face pamphlet, a St. Therese pamphlet, and a Holy Face prayer card. Holy Face items will be available for nominal donation amounts. The items will include Holy Face glass chaplets, 8x10 and 5x7 Holy Face prints, Holy Face medals and prayer cards. No profit is made on Holy Face items.
