#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

As I mentioned last time, I am hoping that this season of Lent will bear the fruit not only of your personal growth in holiness but also your desire to give of yourself in service to others.

This Lent can perhaps be a time to discern where God is calling you to serve. Some service can be visible, such as being a liturgical minister. It is my hope that after Easter we can offer the Precious Blood of Jesus at least at one of our weekend Masses. In order to do this, we will need more people to offer to serve as extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. We are also in need of catechists, teachers, and aids to help bring our students the faith. Family faith formation occurs throughout the entire school year and the need for people to teach is always paramount. For instance, we have been looking for several months for a Marshfield Faith Formation Middle School Coordinator, who would train and support the nine catechists teaching grades 6-8. These are some of the more visible ways one can serve. However, there are also the more hidden ways one can give of themselves. For instance, by chance I recently met one of our parishioners in the grocery store. She shared with me that she was buying groceries so that she could prepare a meal for an elderly person who needed some assistance. This is a silent and beautifully important gesture of charity.

Our Baptism calls each of us to serve in some way. If each of us chose to do just one act of service on a regular basis, really connecting this service to your mission to serve Christ, our parish and our community would be exceedingly blessed. In my next bulletin column I will list all the ways that our parish currently has opportunities to serve. During this Lenten season pray about the way you are called to serve. The Holy Spirit, with gentle encouragement, will plant a seed in your heart. Do not resist this. Your life will be far more blessed when you choose to serve.

Before I entered seminary, I was terrified of speaking and leading. I remember my first attempt to serve in my home parish was visiting an elderly person. Then after some months of this, I was connected in such a way that I began assisting another person in leading the Divine Mercy chaplet for a small group of parishioners. God opened doors gradually and I am forever blessed that I said Yes to these first calls from God.

May you too respond to God. This season of Lent, may you listen to God and see where he is calling you to serve. Blessings to each of you.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.
