#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: first a few practical notes. The front porch of St. John's rectory needs some TLC. The wood posts and railings are beginning to rot. If you or someone you know is handy, please let the parish know. Also, the brick on the church is in need of tuckpointing. I have been calling contractors every month to get a bid. This week one contractor finally responded to my request. If you know a contractor willing to provide a secondary bid for tuckpointing, please let me know. Our church is so beautiful, I hope that it can always remain that way. Thank you.

Ash Wednesday services are noted in the bulletin. Also please keep in mind the fasting regulations during Lent.

1) Catholics who have celebrated their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday. 2) In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, until they celebrate their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

The season of Lent is a time of greater fruitful union with the Lord. As you practice penance and fasting, you open yourself to the presence of God. Fasting gives you a greater capacity to be filled with God. During each Friday evening of Lent we will also offer Stations of the Cross, Adoration, and Confessions. We will also be continuing a series of faith-based talks throughout Lent. Please take advantage of these opportunities.

I am hoping that this season of Lent will bear fruit not only in your own personal holiness but also in your desire to serve our community. It is my hope that after Easter we can offer the Precious Blood of Jesus at least at one of our weekend Masses. To do this, we will need more people to offer to serve in the role of extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. We are also in need of additional persons to serve as lectors, ushers, and servers.

May your season of Lent be fruitful. In practicing penance you create the space for Jesus to enter. Jesus will stretch you, but he will also bless you. Let Jesus do His work in you! Untold graces are available at every Holy Mass.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.
