I encourage all who make use of this dispensation to engage in another sacrificial or charitable act that day.

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: In continuing the theme of the last few bulletin columns - please ask yourself: how do I take the next step? Who do I need to contact to help in some ministry within the parish?

Last week I placed in the bulletin a list of all the active groups and ministries within our parish. It is my prayer that this Lenten season is moving you to consider joining or helping in one of the areas listed. As I mentioned last time, there is great responsibility in being Christian and we must each do our part.

So, who do you contact if you want to help? You can always call the parish office. You can also ask others in the parish. At some point we may create a resource with contact information of every group. However, our parish is a community - not just a list of contacts. Lists with phone numbers can often be impersonal. Our service within the church is deeply relational. When we give ourselves in a relational way, it is then that we overcome loneliness, depression and isolation. To do this, however, we have to take a risk and introduce ourselves. We have to take a risk and ask someone a basic question such as, "Do you know how I can join this group at the parish?"

One such group listed is our Proactive Response Group. This group responds to urgent situations that may arise in our parish family. For instance, if a family of our parish suffers a car accident, we want to be able to provide for our family immediately. This would include such things as running errands, cooking meals, babysitting, etc. We are asking for your help to make this possible. Ron & Patty Kraus, Mike & Stephanie Clubb and Jim & Donna Prepeluh have volunteered to help coordinate this goal. Their contact information will be available on the kiosk at the front entrance. In contacting them you can share the way you wish to make yourself available to help with an immediate need. You can also call the parish office. If you would like to be a contact person for an immediate emergency need, please let us know.

It is amazing how life is filled with blessings when one is willing to offer themselves in generosity to others. Please commit yourself to helping in some way within our parish. Generosity is the foundation of a full life.
