FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: There is a common expression, "God doesn't call the equipped, he equips the called." This is a loose translation of a biblical verse found in 1 Cor 1:28. During this Lent I am continuing to urge each of you to make the leap of faith and assist in one of the many activities in our parish. I do this out of some self-interest. In the past 18 months our diocese has lost a total of 8 priests. In order for myself and our other active priests to remain strong, we need the lay faithful to take initiative in areas of the Gospel.

A few weeks ago, I provided a list of activities we have in our parish. It is very important that you take this list seriously. Do you have the time to do one of the activities? Do you have the ability to join a group within the parish? If you are a caretaker, in poor health, or a parent with young children – this plea is not directed toward you. However, other defenses such as, "I'd do that but" or "I don't have enough ..." are not valid excuses.

Msgr. Gilles, shared in Auburndale a few weeks ago that our life can be symbolized by a circle. Remaining in our circle is comfortable. Stepping out of this circle is scary. However, when you don't hold back, God will bless you. During this Lent I continue to ask you to listen to that voice within you. It may sound dramatic, but what you decide to do today will affect people decades and centuries into the future. Likewise, what you decide not to do today will also impact people for decades and centuries. Take the call to service in the church seriously. God will bless you.

This week I ask you to strongly consider joining in a liturgical ministry within our parish: Usher, Lector, Sacristan, Extraordinary Minister of Communion. I hope to start offering the Precious Blood at least at one of our Masses during the Easter Season. To facilitate this, we will need more individuals to step forward and serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Communion. If you would like to serve in this role, or in any other role within the liturgy, please come to a meeting at 6pm on either March 27 or April 10. If these dates don't work, please call our office and let us know that you are interested in helping.

Your apostolate within the church is a radiation of your holiness. May your season of Lent be fruitful. Jesus will stretch you, but he will also bless you. Let Jesus do His work in you!

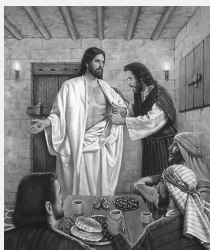
Fourth Week of Lent - A Minute With Jesus

Holy Week, Abortion, and the Wisconsin Supreme Court Race

The PBS Wisconsin headline on Feb. 22 got right to the point: "National debate over abortion turns to Wisconsin Supreme Court race." It was referring to the election that will take place on April 4. It is ironic that this debate – about whether Wisconsin law should continue to protect the lives of unborn children, as it currently does – will culminate in a State Supreme Court election that falls between the Feast of the Annunciation (March 25), when Jesus became Incarnate in the womb of Mary, and Good Friday (April 7), when he was put to death on the Cross. Media coverage of the two Supreme Court candidates and their philosophies is widespread, and abortion has been the constant focal point. Our challenge is to inform ourselves. And then, as we cast our vote on April 4, Tuesday of Holy Week – let us cherish the fact that Jesus himself took on flesh as a tiny, vulnerable child in the womb of Mary, so that one day, on the Cross of Calvary, he might rescue us from darkness and sin.
