Dear Parishioners: The raising of a family necessitates a hope for a bright future. One must be strengthened in this hope when facing the many challenges our youth have today. Please know of my prayers. Stay close to Jesus and Mary. They will protect and bless you in beautiful ways. Please pray each day with your family.
