FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This coming Sunday is First Communion. To accommodate the numerous students receiving First Holy Communion, we will have two additional Masses at 1pm and 3pm. As I mentioned last week, if you have been to our Sunday 9am or 11am Mass, you know how blessed we are with many children and families.

One of the gifts that we provide for our children is the teaching of the faith. This involves sacrifice, but the reward is a new generation of believers. Here in Marshfield, we are blessed with our Catholic School system. Our Columbus Catholic Schools do a wonderful job of providing Catholic education for our youth. I am also so greatly pleased with the number of families who join our school system and as a result become active once again in the faith. In addition to this, we also provide our children an opportunity for faith formation through Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, which happens in the room adjacent to the adoration chapel.

The other path for our youth to receive a Catholic education is through Marshfield Faith Formation. I myself attended public schools. Our farm in Clear Lake was too far away from a Catholic school, so all my Catholic education came through my parents and our parish CCD program. As a result, I have a great appreciation for religious ed programs that assist our public school families in teaching the faith. Here in Marshfield we call this program Marshfield Faith Formation. Grades 1-5 follow a schedule where the parents and children are given formation once a month and in between the parents teach their children the faith at home through a guided program. Grades 6-10 follow LifeTeen, an international Eucharist-centered movement that leads teenagers and their families into a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church.

Marshfield Faith Formation, a collaboration between our four area parishes is overseen by David Alcott. He is assisted by 3 part-time coordinators. These coordinators then oversee our volunteer catechists. This past year we had 6 high school students assist us as catechists. We are so thankful for the generosity of our older youth teaching the younger ones. However, these great catechists are graduating and moving on. Therefore, we need to fill these spaces. I am asking you to please consider helping as a catechist. Catechists can be of any age. Whether you are an adult or an older youth, please consider sharing our faith as a catechist. We are in need of 6 new catechists to teach grades 4th to 8th grades. It is very important that we have enough catechists to assist in the formation of our youth. Every sacrifice we make is in vain if we do not pass on the faith to our next generation.

Let us continue to pray for our families. Stay close to Jesus, Mary and Joseph. The Holy Family will protect and bless our families.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us. Fr. Thelen
