### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### **Dear Parishioners:**

Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. Jesus speaks of his Ascension when he says, "But I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. And when he comes he will convict the world in regard to sin and righteousness and condemnation." (John 16:7)

Jesus spent thirty-three years on this earth. I often wonder why he could not have just remained. Why did Jesus have to leave us at the Ascension? Would not the church run better if Jesus himself remained with us? The Bible Passage I just quoted provides the answer. Jesus says it is better that I go so that the Holy Spirit may come. The Holy Spirit remains with us till the Second Coming. He is powerfully with us in the age of the Church. The Holy Spirit is invisible to our physical sight, but if we are people of prayer, we will perceive the power and presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives. And how joyful we are when we come to know Him!

We could misread the Ascension and think of it as Jesus abandoning his disciples. Abandonment pierces us to the core of our being. The Ascension is not an abandonment, the Ascension is a promise. Jesus promises us the Holy Spirit. "I will not leave you desolate." (John 14:18) "I am with you always, to the close of the age." (Matt. 28:20).

In your own life, when you go through a tragedy, you are not abandoned. God never abandons his people. Rather God offers a promise. He says, I will return again, and in the meantime, I give you the Holy Spirit, the Divine Consoler. He will guide you to all truth, he will heal you of all your hurts, he will give you eternal hope. Trust in Me, Jesus says. "In the world you will have trouble, but take courage, I have conquered the world." (John 16:33)

As summer approaches please keep the Feasts of our Church close to your heart. For the next four Sundays the Church celebrates some of its most important Feasts. Also please keep praying about being a catechist for next year's Marshfield Faith Formation Program. We are in need of at least 6 catechists. As of this writing no one has yet said yes to helping.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.
