**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost. It was on this day, fifty days after Easter, that the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples. The once timid followers of Jesus, through the gift of the Holy Spirit become courageous and fearless in their witness to the truth of Jesus Christ.

Can this happen again? Can we experience the power and presence of the Holy Spirit in such a profound manner? Jesus says yes, for according to His own words it is far better for the Holy Spirit to come than for Jesus to remain, "I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, will not come to you." (John 16:7) The Sacrament of Confirmation in a particular way seals us with the gift of the Holy Spirit. However, like all sacraments, we must live our faith to experience the fruits of the sacrament.

If you enter a church at nighttime with all the lights off, you will notice that the stained-glass windows are no more attractive than the walls of a church. Darkness hides their beauty. However, in the morning or evening as the sun's horizontal light fills the church with its radiance, the stained-glass windows shine with an incredible brilliance that lifts the soul. The sun is what makes stained-glass windows beautiful. The windows on their own cannot store and retain sunlight. They are only beautiful when the sun shines through them. Likewise, in our spiritual life, we only experience the fullness of the Holy Spirit when we daily offer our life's work and prayer to God. To shine brilliantly we must live our faith always!

My own personal experience testifies to this reality. Though I am a priest, I still live in the world. Therefore, I need to actively pray and immerse myself in the presence of God throughout the day. If I do not, I become worldly. I lose the sensitivity to the Holy Spirit. Frequent prayer and persistent reflection upon God, will keep one's desires and yearnings on God alone.

Therefore, as we celebrate Pentecost recommit yourself to prayer. Please pray very much! As Jesus says, "One does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of God." (Matt 4:4) Let us remain in the truth and the presence of Christ.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.

**EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL - PENTECOST**

The Holy Spirit and the Eucharist! Even after the Apostles had experienced the Risen Christ, they were afraid. They gathered with Mary on the day of Pentecost and prayed behind locked doors, waiting as instructed for the Gift of the Holy Spirit. After the Holy Spirit descended upon them on Pentecost, the Apostles were no longer afraid and were equipped to fulfill their mission. It is the same for us today. When we receive the Eucharist, we also receive God the Holy Spirit, to abide in the depths of our hearts. If we allow Him, the Spirit of Truth will transform us and we will no longer be afraid, but be equipped with peace and strength for our mission.

Let us then prepare for each Eucharistic encounter in the same way the Apostles prepared for Pentecost, "in prayer ... with Mary ..." (Acts 1:14). Let's pray this right now and every day this week:

**Sequence for Pentecost**

*Come, Holy Spirit, come!*

*And from your celestial home shed a ray of light divine!*

*Come, Father of the poor! Come, source of all our store!*

*Come, within our bosoms shine.*

*You, of comforters the best; You, the soul's most welcome guest;*

*Sweet refreshment here below; In our labor, rest most sweet;*

*Grateful coolness in the heat; Solace in the midst of woe.*

*O most blessed Light divine, Shine within these hearts of yours,*

*And our inmost being fill!*

*Where you are not, we have naught, Nothing good in deed or thought, Nothing free from taint of ill.*

*Heal our wounds, our strength renew; On our dryness pour your dew;*

*Wash the stains of guilt away:*

*Bend the stubborn heart and will; Melt the frozen, warm the chill;*

*Guide the steps that go astray.*

*On the faithful, who adore and confess you,*

*evermore In your sevenfold gift descend;*

*Give them virtue's sure reward; Give them your salvation, Lord;*

*Give them joys that never end.*

*Amen. Alleluia.*

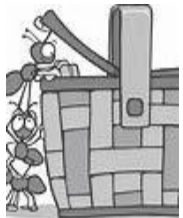

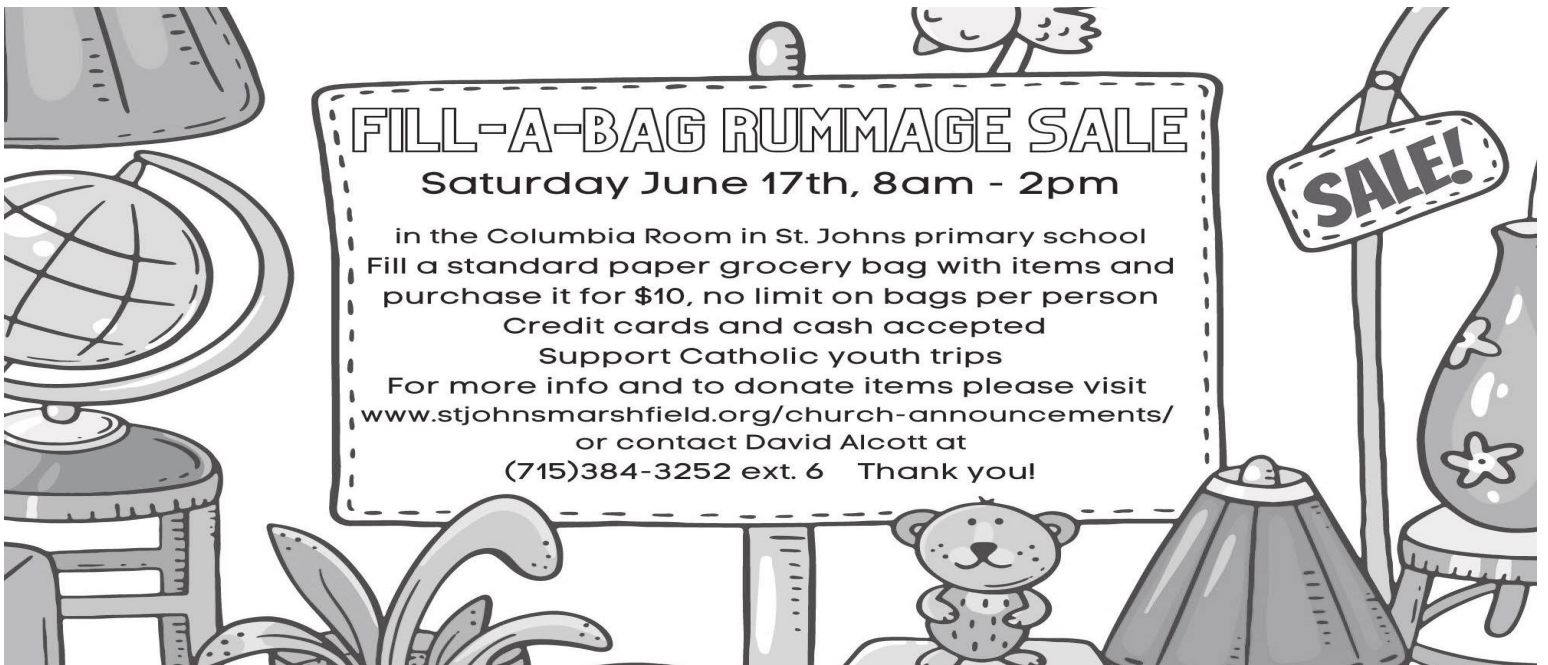
### Diocese of La Crosse Guidelines For Reporting Instances of Child Abuse.

Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or [kbecker@cclse.org](mailto:kbecker@cclse.org). The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: [www.dioc.org](http://www.dioc.org).
