

#### **FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Dear Parishioners: I found the words of Bishop Callahan very powerful in the most recent edition of Catholic Life, our Diocesan magazine. The title of his article was called, "On Being Human." Our Bishop says, "Being human in today's society can sometimes be seen as a deficit rather than the great gift it is...The more we interact with digital devices and become fascinated with artificial intelligence, the more we forget what it means to be human...God made us in friendship. He made us to be in a relationship with Him, and He made us to be in relationship with each other."

He continues with a beautiful quote from St. Catherine of Siena, "What made you establish man in so great a dignity...You are taken with love for her; for by love indeed you created her, by love you have given her a being capable of tasting your eternal Good." Our Bishop continues, "Being human is about living in right relationship with others and with right relationship with self. Human beings are the only part of God's creation who can exercise self-mastery. We express our humanness when we give and receive love; when we share our lives with others and live with a sense of inter-dependence."

Loneliness is omnipresent in today's society. Not knowing one's neighbors is pervasive. We gather each week in church, but we seldom know the people around us. As our Bishop describes, relationships are key for us to be fully happy, fully human.

This weekend we as a community rejoice in the numerous First Communions at our parish. During the afternoon Masses around 33 children will receive the Eucharist for the first time. These children are so excited for their special day! They are filled with joy, but to maintain their faith they will need faith formation. As I mentioned previously, we are in need of catechists to educate our children. Please respond to my request with a Yes! They will need teachers to share with them the faith so that they can truly know Jesus and desire to be confirmed by our Bishop when they become teenagers!! Let us continue to pray for our families.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.

#### Confession – a preparation for receiving the Eucharist

The best way to prepare to receive Jesus in the Holy Eucharist is by going to Confession (also known as the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Penance). We want to receive Him with a clean heart. If it is not possible to go to Confession before receiving Jesus, make a sincere Act of Contrition in your heart, and as always pray with sincerity the prayer at Mass, "I confess to Almighty God..."

A sin that is mortal – serious or grave – requires Sacramental Confession before receiving Holy Communion. If you are not sure about this, speak with a priest.

Let's pray this right now and every day this week:

Jesus, please give me the grace to be truly sorry for my sins.

This week read how God calls us out of darkness into His own wonderful light in 1 Peter 2:9-10?
