#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: This Sunday afternoon, St. Mary's in Auburndale will host our deanery's Corpus Christi Procession. Mass will begin at 2pm and then a procession will follow. In the procession Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament will be carried through the city streets to witness our belief in the real presence of the Body and Blood of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. I remember in my time in Alma Center that during a procession of the Holy Eucharist, a man riding a Harley stopped and made the sign of the cross as we walked across town. The procession is always a powerful witness to our faith.

This feast was made universal for the Church in 1264 following a papal bull by Pope Urban IV. In celebration of this feast, St. Thomas Aquinas composed his most famous hymn, Pange Lingua, of which the last two verses are commonly known by many Catholics, 'Tantum ergo Sacramentum...' During some research I did on this feast in the past, I discovered that the early church had a feast even more ancient than Corpus Christi, which commemorated the 'Birthday of the Chalice' called 'Natalis calicis'. This early feast, first celebrated in the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> centuries, commemorated the sacredness of the Holy Chalice in bearing the sacred Blood of Christ. The ancient feast of the Chalice was observed every year on the night of Holy Thursday, thus connecting the Lord's Chalice intimately to the celebration of the Lord's Supper. The ancient Calendar of Polemius refers to this feast day in the year 448 AD. As many of you may know, every day of the seven-day-week has a particular dedication. For Catholics, Thursdays are traditionally dedicated to the Holy Eucharist.

Sunday: Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ Monday: The Holy Spirit & the Souls in Purgatory

Tuesday: The Holy Angels Wednesday: St. Joseph

Thursday: The Holy Eucharist Friday: Christ's Passion

Saturday: The Blessed Virgin Mary

Thursdays remain connected to the Holy Eucharist since Christ celebrated the Last Supper on a Thursday. Thus, during your work week when you hit Thursday, remember Thursday's importance to the Holy Eucharist. If you have the opportunity, please attend daily Mass or visit a a church and say a few prayers in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament on this day. The more time we spend with Jesus, the more time we will experience His healing and blessings!

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.
