FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: This weekend we welcome Fr. Arturo Vigueras. As I mentioned a few months ago, I lived with Fr. Arturo for one summer several years ago. He was also at Our Lady of Peace as a seminarian. Fr. Arturo was born in California, but then lived in Mexico with his family until he was 15. As a young adult he was confirmed at St. Peter's Parish in Stevens Point. During this time, he was focused on getting his master's degree in law; however, through the people in his life and God's call he was encouraged to change direction and enter seminary. He was ordained a priest in 2021 at the Cathedral in La Crosse. Fr. Arturo speaks both English and Spanish. He will be assisting me here at St. John's and will also be discerning how best to begin Spanish ministry in the Marshfield area.

In addition, to Fr. Arturo's assignment with us, he is also serving as the Administrative Director of Emmaus Retreats. These retreats occur throughout our diocese, and indeed throughout our country. They are conducted in Spanish and through a combination of adoration, music, and testimonies draw individuals into deeper communion with God. Two years ago, I helped Fr. Arturo with one of these retreats in Sparta. An entire team of retreat leaders drove in from Virginia and served for about two days. I remember, in particular, hearing Confessions till 11pm at night in my broken Spanish. Fr. Arturo and other priests, however, continued till 2am. The Confessions were powerful and profound. The experience of the Emmaus retreats are really blessing and strengthening our Spanish speaking Catholics.

Nearly all Hispanics are Catholic; however, many are in non-sacramental marriages/unions. The Emmaus Retreats are critical in drawing Hispanics into a deeper relationship with Christ and leading them to the conversion necessary for the blessing of their marriages and true contrition of the heart. I look forward to Fr. Arturo providing us with his insights into the great work he is doing through the Emmaus retreats. I think our own community here at St. John's will be blessed by the wisdom he will share.

As a result of Fr. Arturo's commitments at the Emmaus Retreats, he will not be with us for most of the weekends in July. However, please welcome him warmly whenever you do see him. I am excited to have him join us here at St. John's!

May St. John the Baptist pray for us and our parish.

EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

The Eucharist is called the Breaking of Bread



At the Last Supper, Jesus gave thanks, then blessed and broke the bread and gave it to the Apostles. Jesus repeated this action on the day of His Resurrection as He shared a meal with the disciples in Emmaus. The disciples had left Jerusalem, believing that Jesus was dead. As Jesus walked with

the disciples to Emmaus, they did not recognize Him. It was in the "breaking of the bread" that He opened their eyes to recognize Him as the risen Lord. This transfigured Bread and Wine – the Eucharist – is the Gift of Himself to them, and now to us.
