FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: Goodbyes are never easy and especially for those whom we care for so much. This weekend is the last weekend that Fr. Williams will be in our parish. Fr. Williams is appointed Associate Pastor of SS. Peter and Paul Parish and St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Wisconsin Rapids with residence at SS. Peter and Paul Parish rectory, effective July 4, 2023. I truly feel blessed to have had the gift of sharing the past year with Fr. Williams.

Fr. Williams was assigned to St. John the Baptist in July of 2020, just a few short days after his ordination. It was a challenging year to become a priest, as CoVid was limiting so many gatherings. However, Fr. Williams handled these difficulties exceptionally well. In his three years with us he baptized 32 children, heard countless Confessions, and celebrated hundreds of Masses. His time at Columbus truly nurtured and supported the faiths of so many of our students. I know that his ministry has impacted and blessed so many.

Goodbyes are never easy; however, I know that his presence has been a blessing for all of us. Our antiphon this weekend for Mass quotes the epistle of St. Peter, "You are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation." Every one of the baptized faithful share in the priesthood of Christ through their Baptism. The ordained priest, however, serves in a special way as a minister of the Sacraments. The Roman Missal describes it this way, "By this nature of the ministerial Priesthood, something else is put in its proper light ... namely, the royal Priesthood of the faithful, whose spiritual sacrifice is brought to completion through the ministry of the Bishop and the Priests, in union with the Sacrifice of Christ, the sole Mediator." (Presbyterorum ordinis, no. 2). Priests are made holy by the lay faithful, just as the lay faithful are made holy by the ministry of the priests. We indeed bless each other.

Please pray for Fr. Williams as he departs from us. Transitions are never easy, but we know that with the grace of God, Fr. Williams will continue to minister faithfully and touch countless new lives with the gift of his priesthood.

EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

The Eucharist is called the Lord's Supper



On the night before He was crucified, Jesus had a meal with His Apostles in the Upper Room. It was at this "Last Supper" before He died that He instituted the Holy Eucharist. This was Jesus' way of remaining with us throughout all time. During supper, Jesus changed the bread and wine into His Body and Blood, saying "This is My Body which is given for you" as He will be crucified the next day. "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My Blood" (Luke 22:19b-

20). Jesus offered His Body and His Blood on the cross so that we could be adopted into the family of God and live united with Him on earth and forever in Heaven.

Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Jesus, thank you for always remaining with us in the Holy Eucharist.
