#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: This weekend at the 9am & 11am Sunday Masses we welcome Fr. Nate Kuhn, the Director of Vocational Recruitment for our Diocese. Many of you know him from his time as an Associate Pastor here at St. John's. We are in great need of vocations to the priesthood and to the religious life. As a Church we must be constantly praying for new vocations and for the strengthening of our current priests and religious. God's grace is the fundamental and essential component of any vocation. It is imperative that we pray and offer penance for this intention.

I have been a priest for eight years and it always casts a wound in my heart when apathy and worldliness dry up the first movements of a vocation in a young person. An even greater sorrow happens when a brother priest walks away from his calling and the joy that Jesus offers in a priesthood generously lived. I have to think that this occurs when a priest quits truly praying (humbling themselves before God) The priesthood and religious life is a life of sacrifice. A life of sacrifice, however, is the only path to a full life. For it is in emptying ourselves of our selfishness, that we can then be filled with Him who is the fullness of life. In this sacrifice we image the Trinity, hence the fullness that comes from sacrifice.

Next week in Mosinee on Aug 6<sup>th</sup> is a 'Dare To Follow Retreat' led by Fr. Kuhn. If you know any of our youth interested in the priesthood between the grades of  $6^{th} - 10^{th}$  grade, please look into attending this retreat.

The following is Fr. Kuhn's latest vocation write-up ~ The first question that Jesus asks in John's Gospel is, "What are you looking for?" He is speaking to John's disciples as they follow after Him, desiring to know who Jesus is and what His mission is all about. After the disciples respond, Jesus gives them an instruction, "Come and you will see!" Whether we can hear it or not, that same question is being asked to you. What are YOU looking for? So often, we find ourselves searching, not knowing exactly where to go or what to do in life. We seek things that will hopefully fill the emptiness and longing that we have in our hearts, but nothing seems to satisfy. The real answer to this can be found in Jesus' response as He invites each of us to follow after Him, to get to know Him, and to follow the path He has placed before us. For some men, that path is a very special invitation to walk in Jesus' footsteps as a priest.
