Dear Parishioners: This past week Krause Konstruction has been working diligently on tuckpointing the church. The bricks on the church and the rectory have needed attention for many years and I am so happy that this project is getting under way. If you have passed by the church on a weekday, you can see the boom truck and the construction workers removing the crumbling bricks and replacing them with new bricks. Modern developments have made it possible to match the color of the existing bricks, hence you probably won't even notice the work having been done when the job is finished. Before August is completed we will also finish up the landscaping around the garage and sealcoat the parking lot.

It's been great seeing some of our major projects getting completed. It has also been a wonderful time in our parish for youth ministry. We also had our Confirmation retreat out at the School Forest. The retreat was led by a nationally known speaker. Fifty-six students from Marshfield will be confirmed on September 17th.

EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

The Eucharist is called the Holy Sacrifice

A sacrifice is an offering of love for someone. Jesus rescued us and set us free from the bondage of sin by offering Himself through His painful sacrifice on the Cross. At each Mass, Jesus offers Himself to the Father for love of us.

Jesus is not being "re-sacrificed" but the sacrifice of Calvary is being made present at each Mass.
