FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: In continuing the theme from last week's bulletin column: November is an important time to pray for our dead. In understanding this, we can ask the question, 'What is the soul and what is its importance?' The Catechism of the Catholic Church describes the "soul" as 'the innermost aspect of man, that which is of greatest value in him, that by which he is most especially in God's image: "soul" signifies the spiritual principle in man.' (363) The soul is immortal: it does not perish when it separates from the body at death, and it will be reunited with the body at the final Resurrection. (366)

These truths of our faith help us to understand the importance of our soul. In Baptism we receive the Holy Spirit and are thereby made adopted sons and daughters of God. The Holy Spirit then dwells within us as we remain in the state of grace. This state of grace can be weakened or removed due to personal sin. However, the damage caused to the soul from personal sin is restored through repentance and in case of mortal sin, through the sacrament of Confession.

The sufferings of life also have an impact upon our souls. In the Second Letter to the Corinthians St. Paul says, "although our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. For this momentary light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison." (2 Cor 4:16-17). Each of our lives are filled with difficulty and suffering. St. Paul recognizes that this difficulty has purpose. Though the struggles of life may wear us down, our inner self, our soul, is renewed day by day if we keep Jesus close to us in our struggles. The sufferings, when united to Christ, then prepare us for an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison.

These are incredible words of hope. Whatever our cross, when we keep Jesus close to us during our sufferings, God will do something beautiful in and through our cross. Our inner self is renewed day by day preparing us for the eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison. The importance of our soul is paramount. May we pray for the souls of all who have died before us and constantly prepare our own soul for the eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us and our parish.
