#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: Where did the Bible come from? Where is the Bible's origin? ...continued from last week... A man named St. Irenaeus was helpful in this task. He listed a number of the books considered canonical in the second century. The common usage of certain books by early churches also contributed and helped. Eventually it was the bishops of the 4<sup>th</sup> century who then made a final decision. Their decision was guided by the Holy Spirit due to their consecration and ordination as bishops. Twenty-seven books were chosen. These 27 books remain the only books in the New Testament of the Bible.

The Bible is therefore compiled and organized by the Catholic Church. It was wrote by early members of the Church and then approved by Bishops ordained in the Roman Catholic Faith. Why then do we shy away from the Bible? Why do we not think that it is a Catholic book? Why are we accused of not knowing the Bible? Why is it commonly assumed that Catholics do not use the Bible?

We need to reclaim our heritage. The Bible is a Catholic book approved and formed by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit through the Catholic Church. As Catholics we need to rejoice in the Bible and place it in a prominent place within our homes. We need to read from it daily. Explore its mysteries. Ponder its questions. Countless online sources can help one navigate and understand the Bible. The most popular podcast in the world at the end of 2020 was produced by a Catholic Priest who simply read and discussed the Bible. Fr. Michael Schmitz, a priest in Duluth, Minnesota produced a podcast called, "The Bible in a Year". This simple yet profound podcast has become the most downloaded podcast in the world at the end of 2020. A Catholic Priest reading and explaining the Bible.

The Bible is a Catholic Book. Its 27 books in the New Testament were compiled and approved by the Bishops of the Catholic Church. It was approved and formed by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit through the Catholic Church.

Finally, as Elijah waited, he heard a soft, quiet whisper. At that, he knelt to the ground and prayed. God often speaks to us, not in grand and impressive ways, but in the silence. When we can still our hearts, that's when we begin to hear His voice, calling us into relationship and to follow Him. Sometimes that invitation is to follow the Lord as one who lovingly serves others in the priesthood.
