#### FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

On Good Friday March 29 at 8:00pm here at St. John's there will be a Tenebrae service. The word Tenebrae is Latin for darkness or shadows and this type of religious service is particular to the Sacred Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday). The Tenebrae Service is a dramatic mourning ritual that dates back centuries. An important part of the Tenebrae service is the use of a triangular stand with fifteen candles that are extinguished one by one until the darkness completely cloaks the church. Perhaps, the most important element of the Tenebrae Service is the environment, the darkness and the stillness of the night as the choir sings the different psalms of laments.

How to Participate in the Tenebrae Service

Participation in the Tenebrae Service is different than in any other liturgies that the church celebrates. The congregation only joins the choir in singing the processional hymn as the presider priest and the other ministers enter the sanctuary of the church. During the rest of the service as the choir sings the different psalms of lament and the priest offers the prayers throughout the service the congregation will respond with the traditional Amen as we normally do in the Mass. Throughout the service the role of the congregation is to listen and to prayerfully ponder and meditate on what is being sung and to consider the significance of the darkness as we accompany our Lord into His journey towards the grave.

Spiritual and Biblical Significance of the Tenebrae Service

The darkness of the Tenebrae Service not only provides the atmosphere of reflection on Christ's death, but it also symbolizes the darkness that Jesus experienced as He hung on the cross. The synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark, and Luke) go out of their way to tell us that darkness covered the land during Jesus' Crucifixion. The scriptures tell us that a shroud of darkness covered the land. This was a supernatural sign of judgment on sin. Also, on the day on which our Lord was crucified the prophesy of the prophet Isaiah was being fulfilled which said Christ "was pierced for our transgressions, he was crush for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him and by his wounds we are healed (Is.53: 5).

It was our transgressions that Our Lord Jesus Christ took upon himself, and because of those transgressions Jesus experienced the pain of being separated from our Heavenly Father.

To fully unite ourselves to the sufferings of Christ in the last moments of His life please observe the following quidelines:

- Do not bring your own personal flashlights.
- Please do not use your cellphones as flashlights.
- Listen and meditate on what the choir will be singing.

Wishing you a prayerful and blessed Holy Week.

Diocesan News: His Holiness, Pope Francis, has accepted the resignation of our Bishop William Callahan. Bishop Gerard W. Battersby will be installed as the 11th Bishop of the Diocese of La Crosse on May, 20, 2024

Bishop Battersby was born on 15 May 1960. In 1993, he entered Sacred Heart Major Seminary and received a Master of Divinity degree in 1998. After ordination to the priesthood, he served in parish ministry for ten years. In 2008 he received a Licentiate in the New Evangelization. Bishop Battersby then served as director of graduate seminarians and graduate pastoral formation at Sacred Heart Major Seminary, Detroit. In 2011, he was appointed Vice-Rector and Dean of Seminary Formation. In January 2017 he was ordained to the Episcopacy as an Auxiliary Bishop of Detroit and Moderator of the South Region.
