FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: In the preceding weeks we have discussed: Death, Judgment and Heaven; three of the 'Last Things'. This week we will delve into the Catholic understanding of 'Hell' to complete our discussion.

The great poet Dante Alighieri wrote of Hell in his famous poem The Divine Comedy. Dante describes Hell as various levels of cold. At the pit of Hell is the Devil, frozen in his hatred, far removed from the warmth of God's love. Christ, however, speaks of Hell as the place where worm does not die (Mark 9:48), as a burning pool of fire and sulfur (Rev 21:8), as a fiery furnace, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth (Matt 13:50), and as an eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels (Matt 25:41). St. Paul says, "The damned will pay the penalty of eternal ruin, separated from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his power." (2 Thes 1:9)

From these brief passages we can gather the following knowledge about Hell. First of all, Hell exists. Jesus refers to Hell on numerous occasions in Scripture. Secondly, Hell is a place of separation from God's love. God wishes all to be saved; however, God also respects an individual's free will. An individual, through their free will, can reject the love of Jesus through mortal sin. By persevering in their unrepentance, these individuals by their free will are rejecting life with God. Jesus respects their decision. Unrepentant mortal sin leads to eternal separation from God.

Thirdly, it is a place of suffering. Jesus uses physical terms to describe this suffering. He equates the sufferings of Hell to an eternal fire, a place of grinding teeth, etc. These physical descriptions try to communicate what is considered to be the greatest of the sufferings in Hell: the loss of God. Souls in Hell have rejected God; they suffer because without God there is no love, there is no goodness, there is no peace. Hell is the absence of all that is good, true and beautiful.

St. Catherine of Siena, a famous mystic, says the following of Hell, "I saw the torments of hell and those of purgatory; no words can describe them. Had poor mortals the faintest idea of them, they would suffer a thousand deaths rather than undergo the least of their torments during a single day."

God is love as St. John tells us (1 John 4:8) and where there is no God there is no love! God is indeed a God of great, infinite mercy, but we need to cooperate with Him in ensuring our salvation by living a good, loving, and humble life. Repent, follow the commandments, and never fail to confess mortal sins so as to be restored to God's graces and friendship. As long as we have breath within us, we can choose Eternal Life and receive God's love and mercy. Dear parishioners, a discussion on Hell is never easy to hear. However, know that in Jesus we have our advocate, our protector. Remain strong in your faith and you have nothing to fear. God loves you.

May St John the Baptist pray for us and our parish.
