FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: This Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. This special feast marks the end of the octave of Easter by focusing on the great gift of the mercy of Jesus. Mercy is God's greatest attribute. We should always remember that God desires to dispense his mercy. Each of us are worthy of God's mercy. We should never abandon our hope in God's mercy.

We see in the events following the Resurrection how those with authority tried to hide the truth of the Resurrection. We hear in the Gospel of Matthew, "The chief priests and elders gave a large sum of money to the soldiers, telling them, "You are to say, 'His disciples came by night and stole him while we were asleep.' And if this gets to the ears of the governor, we will satisfy him and keep you out of trouble." The soldiers took the money and did as they were instructed." With these words the authorities silenced the news of the Resurrection.

How sad it is when those in authority silence the truth. Those who are in power often compromise the truth to hold onto their power. Injustice of this nature happens too often. Perhaps you see this in your own family or even within your own self. In every situation where truth needs to be spoken do not remain silent. Speak always with love and compassion.

As we focus on mercy on this Divine Mercy Sunday, we must know that justice and mercy are never in opposition to one another. Truth must be spoken to bring justice to every situation; however, at the same time Mercy must be extended. This is especially true with our selves. Perhaps there is an event in your past. You have taken it to Confession. You have received forgiveness from God, but you have not given yourself the permission to receive mercy. You still feel guilty for what you have done. In this situation God wants to share his mercy. He wants to bestow his love upon you and set you free. Therefore, receive his ineffable mercy. Give yourself permission to receive his mercy.

Justice and mercy are never opposed in God. Truth and justice must be sought in every situation of injustice. At the same time, no situation is beyond the capacity and desire of Jesus to extend His mercy. Jesus died and rose for all of us. On this Divine Mercy Sunday receive the mercy of God.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us and our parish. Fr. Thelen
