
St. Cyril of Jerusalem, a bishop of Jerusalem in the 4th century, describes the Holy Spirit in the following profound words, "The Spirit comes gently and makes himself known by his fragrance. He is not felt as a burden, for he is light, very light. Rays of light and knowledge stream before him as he approaches. The Spirit comes with the tenderness of a true friend and protector to save. to heal, to teach, to counsel, to strengthen, to console."

"As light strikes the eyes of a man who comes out of darkness into the sunshine and enables him to see clearly things he could not discern before, so light floods the soul of the man counted worthy of receiving the Holy Spirit and enables him to see things beyond the range of human vision, thing hitherto undreamed of."

Please develop a relationship with the Holy Spirit. Without the Holy Spirit our parish will not grow. However, if we open ourselves to the Holy Spirit and dedicate our lives to prayer, fasting and the living of the moral life, our parish will be fruitful. We will have conversions in our community. Jesus Thirsts Coming to Rogers Cinema in Marshfield A new film focusing on the transformative power of the Eucharist will be showing at Rogers Cinema in Marshfield on June 4^{th} , 5^{th} , and 6^{th} at 7:00pm each night (The showing on June 6th will have Spanish subtitles). Jesus Thirsts: The Miracle of the Eucharist will take viewers on a journey to rediscover the importance of the Eucharist through dialogue with notable Catholic figures including Father Donald Calloway, Scott Hahn, Jim Wahlberg, Curtis Martin, Chris Stefanick, Father Robert Spitzer, Bishop Andrew Cozzens, and Tim Gray, among others. Deacon Steve Greco, the

executive producer of the film, explained that amid the ongoing Eucharistic Revival in the U.S., he felt it was "very critical that we have a movie focusing on the real presence of Jesus with top Catholic theologians and leaders." Greco added that they partnered with the Knights of Columbus to add a 13-minute adjunctive film, produced by the Knights of Columbus, titled Our Lady of Guadalupe: Woman of the Eucharist. The short film will air after Jesus Thirsts and explores the centrality of the Eucharist in that famous Marian apparition. He added, "We really believe that every priest, every deacon, every bishop, every Catholic needs to see this."

The Holy Spirit and the Eucharist Even after the Apostles experienced the Risen Christ, they were afraid. They gathered with Mary on the day of Pentecost and prayed behind locked doors, waiting as

instructed for the Gift of the Holy Spirit. After the Holy Spirit descended upon them on Pentecost, the Apostles were no longer afraid and were equipped to fulfill their mission. It is the same for us today. When we receive the Eucharist, we also receive God the Holy Spirit, to abide in the depths of our hearts. If we allow Him, the Spirit of Truth will transform us and we will no longer be afraid, but be equipped with peace and strength for our mission. Let us then prepare for each Eucharistic encounter in the same way the Apostles prepared for Pentecost, "in prayer ... with Mary ..." (Acts
