FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: This past Monday, Fr. Arturo and I, had the pleasure of attending the installation Mass of our new bishop, the Most Reverend Gerard W. Battersby, the Eleventh Bishop of La Crosse. I will share his brief biography, but before I do I want to share one testimony. Prior to the installation Mass I spent about two hours in the Blessed Sacrament chapel of the Cathedral in prayer, Halfway through Bishop Battersby entered. There were just a few of us priests and him. It was a special gift to witness him in prayer. He entered in silence, venerated our Lord, and then proceeded to pray the Rosary. His love for both the Eucharist and the Rosary is a testament to the blessing we have in our new bishop. I, please ask you to pray for him as I know he is doing for us.

The youngest of nine children, Gerard W. Battersby was born, along with his twin brother, on May 15, 1960, to the late Christopher and the late Helen (Buckley) Battersby. He grew up in northwest Detroit and attended St. Benedict Parish and School in Highland Park. In 1993, he entered Sacred Heart Major Seminary as an adult vocation and received a Master of Divinity degree in 1998. Cardinal Adam J. Maida ordained him to the priesthood on May 30, 1998. After ordination, he served in parish ministry for approximately 10 years. He served as an associate pastor at St. Thecla Parish in Clinton Township, Presentation/Our Lady of Victory Parish, Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish and St. Gerard Parish, all in Detroit.

In 2002, he was named pastor of St. Christopher Parish in Detroit, and in 2007, was appointed to Sacred Heart Maior Seminary, where he received a Licentiate in the New Evangelization in 2008. While serving as director of graduate seminarians and graduate pastoral formation at the seminary, Father Battersby also served concurrently as administrator of St. Leo Parish in Detroit. In 2009, Father Battersby was assigned to graduate studies at the Angelicum in Rome, Italy. In 2011, Father Battersby was appointed vice-rector and dean of seminarian formation at Sacred Heart Major Seminary. In 2015, Father Battersby was concurrently appointed pastor of St. Mary of Redford Parish, Detroit.

Father Battersby was appointed as Auxiliary Bishop of Detroit on Nov. 23, 2016 and his episcopal ordination occurred shortly thereafter on Jan. 25, 2017. Archbishop Allen H. Vigneron served as the principal consecrator and main celebrant. On March 19, 2024, His Holiness Pope Francis named Bishop Battersby as the 11th Bishop of the Diocese of La Crosse.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us, our new bishop and our parish.



Jesus Thirsts Coming to Rogers Cinema in Marshfield A new



film focusing on the transformative power of the Eucharist will be showing at Rogers Cinema in Marshfield on June 4th, 5th, and 6th at 7:00pm each night (The showing on June 6th will have Spanish subtitles). Jesus Thirsts: The Miracle of the Eucharist will take viewers on a journey to rediscover the importance of the Eucharist through dialogue with notable Catholic figures including Father Donald Calloway, Scott Hahn, Jim Wahlberg, Curtis Martin, Chris Stefanick, Father Robert

Spitzer, Bishop Andrew Cozzens, and Tim Gray, among others. Deacon Steve Greco, the executive producer of the film, explained that amid the ongoing Eucharistic Revival in the U.S., he felt it was "very critical that we have a movie focusing on the real presence of Jesus with top Catholic theologians and leaders." Greco added that they partnered with the Knights of Columbus to add a 13-minute adjunctive film, produced by the Knights of Columbus, titled Our Lady of Guadalupe: Woman of the Eucharist. The short film will air after Jesus Thirsts and explores the centrality of the Eucharist in that famous Marian apparition. He added, "We really believe that every priest, every deacon, every bishop, every Catholic needs to see this."
