THE DEACON IS SPEAKIN'

AHH!! August, the "Dog Days" of summer...scorching heat, oppressive humidity, sweltering nights and lots and lots of bugs...especially flies...all the reasons I left the South and came North tied up in one month of thirty-one days. To be fair, August does have it's good points. There are two (three if you're Irish) beautiful Marian feasts to be celebrated. The Assumption (a Holy Day of Obligation) reminds us of Mary's purity and of what God has in store for us: eternal life with Him.

On the twenty-second is the Memorial of the Queenship of Mary; a reminder that Mary has been crowned Queen of Heaven and Earth and holds a special place in our hearts.

For the Irish (and we of Irish descent) there is the one hundred and forty-sixth anniversary of the apparition in Knock, County Mayo on August 21st. Mary appeared with her spouse Joseph and St. John the Evangelist and beloved disciple. With them was the Lamb of God on an Altar glorified. Although not a word was spoken, there was the undeniable message of Hope and that the Lamb will conquer and Mary will shed her light on us all.

As a Deacon, I must mention August 10th, it is the Feast of St. Lawrence, Deacon and Martyr and one of the two patron saints for deacons. When the Romans demanded that he bring them the treasure of the Church, Lawrence brought them the poor of Rome saying, "Behold the treasure of the Church." We are reminded that the wealth of the Church lies not behind Vatican walls, not in our great cathedrals or beautiful buildings. NO!! We are the treasure of the Body of Christ...the greatest treasure of the Church.

There is a need for lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. This is a wonderful opportunity to share your gifts with the community of St. John's and answer the universal call to holiness. Training and commissioning will be in September. Contact the parish office if interested.

A sacrifice is an offering of love for someone. Jesus rescued us and set us free from the bondage of sin by offering Himself through His painful

sacrifice on the Cross. At each Mass, Jesus offers Himself to the Father for love of us. Jesus is not being "re-sacrificed" but the sacrifice of Calvary is being made present at each Mass. To express our gratitude and to open our hearts more deeply to Him, we can show our love by offering small sacrifices to Him: our willingness to forgive after being hurt by someone, cutting our time short with TV to take time for prayer, visiting someone who is sick etc.

Let's pray this right now and every day this week:

Thank You, Jesus, for loving me so much that You were willing to die in order to save me and set me free from the bondage of sin.

This week, read how we are to imitate Jesus by walking in the way of love in Ephesians 5:2

"Walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved me and gave Himself up for me as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God"


