FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: The new School year will begin soon! I am sure this brings a mix of emotions to students, parents and teachers. Every new year, however, is an opportunity for new beginnings and new growth.

As Christians one of the best ways we can give of our time is to assist in some component of faith formation for our children. Here at St. John's we have three primary ways that the faith is communicated to our youth. Volunteers are key to the success in each of these areas.

The first is at our Catholic schools. School begins at Columbus Catholic Schools on Tuesday, August 27th. This year we will have again a sizeable increase of students enrolled. Here at St. John's we had to add an additional teacher at the 1st grade level, increasing the number of 1st grade classrooms from three to four. Volunteers serving as aids for our Catholic school teachers are always an important component to helping our students flourish. If you are interested in assisting in this manner, please contact Columbus.

Secondly, we continue to offer our Marshfield Faith Formation Program. This program is a collaboration of our three Catholic parishes in the greater Marshfield area: Our Lady of Peace, Sacred Heart and St. John the Baptist. In combining our religious education programs into one program, we have adopted the family formation approach. This has provided opportunities for both students and parents to receive catechetical instruction. We are always in need of new teachers and aids to assist in the teaching of students. Classes meet on Wednesday evenings throughout the school year on a monthly or bi-weekly basis.

Third, we offer Catechesis of the Good Shepherd in the room adjacent to our perpetual adoration chapel below the church. This is a Montessori based Catholic faith formation program where children ages (3-9) can grow in their relationship with God through a deep engagement in Scripture and liturgy. Instructors for this important outreach are also needed.

In addition, to these three core areas we also offer our Cherubs program at the 9am Mass on Sundays during the homily. Additionally, through the MERIT program we offer catechesis to children with special needs. Finally, we hope this year to kickstart more activities for our teenage youth to participate in as they prepare for and live out their Confirmation.

If you have any interest in helping in any of these areas, please reach out. Saying no to this, may be saying no to a child's opportunity to know Jesus.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us and our parish.

Encounter Jesus in the Eucharist.

At Mass, the Scripture Readings prepare us to receive Jesus

in the Eucharist.

He waits for you!

There are two major parts to the Mass: the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. In the Liturgy

of the Word, we listen to three Readings and a Psalm from Sacred Scripture (the Bible). These Readings help us recall all that God has done for us: His love and His plan for us. We stand up for the third Reading – the Gospel, the most important Reading – because Matthew, Mark, Luke and John deliver the message that Jesus brings, and include quotations of HIs very own spoken words. After the Gospel, the priest or deacon help us to understand these Readings from the Bible and how to apply the message to our daily life in order to be a more faithful follower of the Lord. Hearing the Words of Scripture and the Homily which follows helps our hearts to receive Jesus in the Eucharist.

Let's pray this right now and every day this week:

Jesus, help me to come to Mass with an open heart, ready to
hear the Readings from Scripture and the Homily in order to
know You better.

This week, read from the Letter of Paul to Timothy about the importance of God's Word: "All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for reproof, correction and training in righteousness, so that the man (or woman) of God may be fully competent and equipped for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) will be begins on September 5th with full entrance into the church occurring at Easter of 2025. OCIA is the process whereby a person learns about the beautiful Catholic faith that we sometimes take for granted. Catholic but never been Confirmed? This class is for you as well! Please contact the parish office if you or someone you know is interested in becoming Catholic or if you just want to deepen your understanding of the faith.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd will be offered again this year

but help is needed! Catechesis begins starting at the end of Sept. and goes through April. There are 3 sessions to volunteer for: Mondays from 2:30-5pm; Tuesday mornings from 9-11am and Tues. afternoons from 2:30-5pm. This is an opportunity for children ages 3-9 to grow closer to



Jesus. If this sounds like something that you are drawn to do, please call Jean at 715-387-0571.


