

#### THE DEACON IS SPEAKIN'

This month a group of us will be going on a pilgrimage with Father Barry, "In the footsteps of St. Paul." There will be pilgrims from Christ the King and St. John's as well as from as far away as San Antonio (friends of Fr. Barry) and Memphis (my twin sister and her friend). We will be visiting Ephesus, Athens, Hagia Sophia in Istanbul and the Aegean Sea. This will be Rita and my sixth pilgrimage having been to Rome, Ireland, Lourdes and Fatima and the Holy Land twice. Each trip was a wonderful experience with many powerful memories.

If you ever have the opportunity to visit these holy sites, I highly recommend that you do so. Going on a pilgrimage is an ancient tradition in our church. Chaucer's *Canterbury Tales* is the story of a group of people on a pilgrimage; for centuries people have walked the "Camino" in northern Spain to visit the burial place of St. James; Constantine's mother, St. Helena, went to Jerusalem and people have been traveling to holy sites throughout Christendom since the earliest years of the Church.

But you don't have to travel for months or even days to go on a pilgrimage. Our state has several places you can spend a day or even just a few hours. Our Lady of Good Hope in Champion just outside of Green Bay; Holy Hill near Milwaukee; the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe near La Crosse are just a few of the holy sites you can easily visit. I invite you to take a day and visit one of these sites. They are well worth the effort. And know that I will pray for all of you "In the footsteps of St. Paul".
