Central Chamber Chorale Sacred Music Through the Ages All are welcomed to attend this beautiful Chorale presentation at First Presbyterian Church, 200 S. Lincoln Ave., Marshfield on Sunday, November 17th at 3pm. Free admission. Listeners are invited to embark on a rich exploration of sacred music, beginning in the Renaissance period, where the ethereal harmonies and polyphonic textures of composers like William Byrd set a spiritual tone. Moving forward, the Baroque era is represented in the stately styles of Bach and Vivaldi, whose works are renowned for their intricate counterpoint. The Classical period is brought to life with pieces such as the contemplative "Kyrie" from Schubert's "Mass in G," which reflects a holy reverence. Each era's music not only reflects its own time but also evokes timeless spiritual themes, making this a journey through the evolution of sacred music across centuries.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: At St. John's we are blessed with a good number of Baptisms every year. The latter part of this year has been particularly wonderful in this regard. From mid-October to the first weekend of December we as a parish have had 17 Baptisms! We are averaging about 2 Baptisms every week!

It is a joy for me to celebrate these Baptisms and especially the Baptisms of the children from the marriages I have celebrated here in our parish. In my 2 ½ years here at St. Johns, I have celebrated about 20 marriages and now many of these couples are having children. It is wonderful seeing so many of these couples at our Sunday Masses and then in time announcing to me that they are expecting. I get to see the full circle of love and new life!

Baptism is an incredible gift for a child. Every child born in the world is made in God's image and likeness. However, in Baptism the child's relationship to God is deepened. Through Baptism they are given the special relationship of being an adopted son or daughter of God. Following their Baptism every child is anointed with the chrism of salvation 'so that each child may remain members of Christ, Priest, Prophet and King.'

Prior to the Baptism the priest, the parents and the godparents each mark the child's forehead with a sign of the cross. In being baptized, every parent is signing their child up to be a disciple of Jesus. Jesus says, 'Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple.' Baptism assists in understanding how our crosses united to the Cross of Jesus becomes fruitful and salvific. Baptism is a joyous occasion, but it is also a serious matter, for it is here that the child is first engaged in the Christian mystery.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us, our parish, our diocese and all missions.


