FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: As many of you know since 2010 I have been part of a mission called Chalice of Mercy providing humanitarian aid to Ukraine. In 2013 I visited the Ukrainian cities of Zaporozhe and Dnipropetrovsk. Having had this closeness to Ukraine for so many years and having had visited the country, my heart has ached greatly seeing the suffering Ukraine has endured throughout the war.

I am blessed to announce this year that on January 12th, The Most Reverend Vitaliy Kryvytskyi, the Roman Catholic Diocesan bishop of the Diocese of Kyiv–Zhytomyr in Ukraine, will be visiting our parish. Joining this Ukrainian bishop will be our very own Bishop Battersby. Both Bishop Battersby and Bishop Vitaly will celebrate the Mass at 11am here at St. John's on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on Sunday, January 12th.

Bishop Vitaliy will be accompanied by his translator, a priest from Florida. He will also be joined by Valentyna Pavsyukova, the founder of Chalice of Mercy and Genia Samborska from Human Life International. It's incredible the amount of Pro-Life work each of these individuals have done in the last few decades. My friend Valentyna has organized pilgrimages that has led to the conversion of over 1500 abortion doctors.

Following the 11am Mass will be a luncheon in the Columbia Room. We will have the normal Sunday Mass schedule on the weekend. Space, however, will be tight for the 11am Mass. Everyone is welcome at the Mass and I hope we have a great showing for this wonderful event. However, please be patient and prepared if overcrowding causes any limitations. The church seats about 400 people. Regarding the meal, we will have a sign-up sheet in the back of the church beginning right after Christmas. We are working on details but will serve the meal in either the Columbia room or Shuh Hall with overflow going into the latter of the rooms. The first 200 people to sign up will be given preference to the primary serving room. We hope to set up a Live Stream for those in the overflow room.

Bishop Vitaly is seeking financial assistance for his diocese in Ukraine. He oversees the city of Kiev, a city of 5 million people. We will have a 2nd collection at the 11am Mass on January 12th for his diocese. Donations can also be mailed to the parish. A separate blurb in the bulletin beginning in January will provide details on how to donate
