FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: We are about half-way into the Season of Advent. We can ask. What are the obligations of a Catholic during the Advent season?

The Catechism says the following of Advent: "During Advent the Church makes present the ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for his second coming." (524) Thus, the goal of Advent is to make present for ourselves and our families the "ancient expectancy of the Messiah...by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming."

Every church season has a purpose. Lent is about penance. Christmas is about the birth of Jesus. Easter is about the Resurrection. The purpose of Advent is a bit more difficult to define. Advent is about yearning, preparation, and anticipation. It's a season of anticipation and rejoicing but with a penitential nature. Advent is the preparation of our soul for both the Second Coming of Jesus and also for the coming of Christmas.

The focus of Advent is not as penitential as Lent. However, the season of Advent should include some type of penance. The violet color in Advent communicates the importance of penance in this season. A penance could be giving something up, saying an extra prayer, or performing acts of charity.

During Advent, we are also invited to enter more frequently into silence, into prayer and reflection, into Scripture, and into the sacramental life of the Church, all to prepare for celebrating Christmas. Advent is a period of devout and expectant delight. Advent is the preparation of our soul for Christmas.

In furthering our understanding of Advent, The Catholic Encyclopedia from 1907, an encyclopedia which can be found online, says this of Advent.


to prepare themselves worthily to celebrate the anniversary of the Lord's coming into the world,


