In need of consolation due to the loss of a loved one or feeling overwhelmed caring for a family or friend? The bereavement ministry is expanding and will be providing faith-based support groups for people who have experienced the pain and grief of

The faith-based support groups assist those who grieve by using scripture and faith-sharing questions that help direct all to the Lord. FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: This weekend we have the great privilege of welcoming our very own Bishop Battersby. He was installed as our bishop 7 months ago on May 20th. We are exceptionally blessed to have a shepherd so close to the heart of Jesus lead our diocese. In his brief time as our Ordinary, he has visited many of the churches in our diocese. I thank him for his generosity in accepting my invitation to come to St. John the Baptist and to celebrate with us. I rejoice also that he gets to come during the Christmas season and see our beautiful sanctuary so wonderfully decorated.

As you well know, not only will Bishop Battersby be with us, but he will also be joined by the Bishop Vitalii, the Bishop of Kiev in Ukraine. Together they will celebrate the Mass here at our parish on Sunday, January 12th, at 11am. It is a wonderful honor to have this visit from two successors of the Holy Apostles. We will have the normal schedule of weekend Masses. At the 11am Mass, please be patient and prepared overcrowding causes any limitations. The church seats about 400 people.

Bishop Vitalii has been in the center of the devastating war that has ravaged his country. Just a few weeks ago one of his cathedrals sustained damage as a missile exploded just outside of his cathedral, causing the deaths of civilians and the shattering of all the stainedglass windows in his church. I look forward to Bishop Vitalii's arrival and our presence giving him solace as he shepherds his flock in such a difficult time.

Following the 11am Mass will be a luncheon in Schuh Hall, with overflow into the Columbia Room. Regarding the meal, those who have signed up will be given preference to the primary serving room. We hope to set up a Live Stream for those in the overflow room.

Bishop Vitalii is seeking financial assistance for his diocese in Ukraine. He oversees the city of Kiev, a city of 5 million people. We will have a 2nd collection at the 11am Mass on January 12th for his diocese. Donations can also be mailed to the parish. Mass Intentions - the stipends for Masses has remained the same for over 30 years throughout the Dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently when the Bishops of the state of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that the stipends should be adjusted. Mass stipends will now be \$20 (formerly \$10). As always, Mass stipends are paid to the parish and not the priest directly.

Please note the following guidelines on scheduling a Mass:

- Only one scheduled intention can be booked per Mass. This one scheduled intention can have no more than three names within the intention.
- A family can book no more than four scheduled Masses per person in a calendar year and only two of those can be weekend Masses.
- Masses for 2025 are fully booked.
- The calendar for Mass Intentions for 2026 are now open. Please call or drop in during business hours to schedule. Please know that some dates might not be available as we honored first the recently deceased.
