FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. John the Baptist Parish Family:

As we have now entered back into the season of ordinary time, each of us is now called to put into action our call to evangelize. To evangelize means that we make known the love of God in the gift of his truth which comes from his sacred word. We do not have to be theologians to do this work of evangelization. A simple way to do this work is to simply let somebody know why you love God. Perhaps you might also tell them how God has worked in our lives. Of course, we can't forget to be people of hope. Hope comes from God through his gift of new life he wants to give to us through the gift of the resurrection.

This weekend Holy Mother Church offers us another unique Sunday feast. On this Sunday we celebrate the feast of Saints Peter and Paul. On this feast day I would like to pray in a particular way for any parish in our diocese named Peter and Paul. St. Peter and St. Paul I would say are the first two great evangelists who made Jesus's message known after his Ascension to the Father. These two great apostles were instrumental in bringing about the early beginnings of the church.

According to the Order of Prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours and Celebration of the Eucharist St. Peter under Nero was a fisherman and a spokesman for the 12. Peter became the prince of the apostles. St. Peter is the patron saint of those in the fishing industry. "St. Paul according to tradition was martyred in Rome in the year 67. Paul became the apostle to the Gentiles. His letters may be dated from the year 52 to the year 65 and he is the patron of the lay apostolate of the Cursillo movement and Catholic action." (Ordo p. 165)

Through the intercession of Saints Peter and Paul may we now become the apostles of this current age. Now more than ever we need to proclaim with love and boldness our faith in God. We also need to proclaim to the housetops God's love for us in the promise of new life that awaits us at the end of our journey of faith. John the Baptist the patron of our parish foretold with great passion and vigor the coming of the Savior. He also was not afraid to proclaim the message of repentance which would end up being the hallmark of Jesus's message and ministry. Through the intercession of St. John the Baptist and Saints Peter and Paul may we follow the call we have received to be bearers of the good news.

St. Peter and St. Paul pray for us. Let us also pray for the three men who were ordained to the priesthood on June 28:

Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend Gerard Battersby, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or kbecker@cclse.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: www.dioclc.org. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.
