#### THE DEACON IS SPEAKIN'

Today, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, is a great time to contemplate what is at the very core of our Christian faith, the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity. A mystery in this sense is not something to be solved like a story about Sherlock Holmes or an Agatha Christi novel. No, a mystery in this sense is something that can never be understood or "solved". The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is so far beyond our comprehension that we can never fully understand its beauty or comprehend its true meaning.

All we can really do is accept the truth of the Trinity and continue to proclaim our faith in its reality. Whenever we pray the Nicene Creed, which we do every Sunday at Mass, we tell the world and ourselves that we; believe in One God, the Father Almighty, maker of all things seen and unseen; we believe in Jesus Christ who is God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God consubstantial with the Father; and we believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of Life who proceeds from the Father and the Son.

Whenever we begin or end our prayers with the Sign of the Cross, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" or accept a blessing with the same formula we are proclaiming our acceptance of the profound doctrine that there is only one God but that He is three divine persons.

Other Monotheistic religions may call us polytheists but there really is only one God Father, Son and Holy Spirit. I do not know how this is possible. I only know that it is because Jesus says so and that's good enough for me.

Today is also Father's Day, a day set aside to honor all Fathers both biological and spiritual and so we do. We pray for all fathers even those studying Canon Law in Washington D. C.
