FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: Greetings from Catholic University of America! I have been in the thick of studies now for about 4 weeks. This coming Tuesday I will have my first set of finals – a combination of oral exams, which one of my professors wryly calls a 'celebration of knowledge'!

So, what have I been learning? Some of the words that pop-up in my notes are: territorial prelature, titular bishop, episcopal conference, canonical mission, papal legate, etc. In one class alone I have been assigned to read 1,400 pages of church documents and commentary.

Classes have been Monday-Friday from 8:30am-12:30pm. I have 16 other students in my class. Some are brother priests from states around the country such as Indiana, Virginia and Pennsylvania. One classmate is an Augustinian Friar from Pakistan. Another is an Irish priest serving in Peru. I also have a classmate who is a permanent Deacon from Michigan.

I live in a seminary directly across from the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. The Basilica is massive and is the largest Catholic church building in America, with a seating capacity of 10,000 people. From out my window I see hundreds of people daily entering within the basilica to pray. As I walk to class, I am frequently seeing fellow priests. This past week about 100 Dominican friars in their long flowing white habits used the campus for their annual retreat. It was neat seeing the younger friars giving the older one's rides in golf carts to and from their meetings.

The weather is warm, but I am greatly surprised that I have not experienced one mosquito this whole month of June. I take walks through the city and I am just shocked that Wisconsin's state bird, the mosquito, never bothers me in DC. That being said, I am missing the quiet of Wisconsin, the rural landscapes and most especially all of you! It is strange not preaching on a regular basis and ministering the sacraments to our parish. I have private Masses each day, pray my Rosary and the Office, and in each prayer, I am remembering all of you.

Please pray for me in my finals! I will write again in July and then will be back July 29th. Looking forward to seeing you all when I return!

May St. John the Baptist pray for us and bless us.
