#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: The two months are nearly complete! I so greatly appreciate Fr. MIsna, Deacon Jeff and all the priests who have assisted during my absence. A big thank you to our staff also. They are incredible! They have done such a good job of keeping everything running smoothly. I get weekly updates on how things are going and sometimes daily pictures of our many projects being completed. I can't wait to return and see you all again - and to see the many things done on our campus during my absence: the new landscaping, the remodeled Columbia room and kitchen, and the brand new playground - just to name a few!

My finals following my June classes went well. Both finals were oral exams. So basically this means that I sat down with the professor for fifteen minutes and the professor asked questions from anything that was taught during the 40 hours of class.

This month I am studying the canons on all of the sacraments, apart from Holy Orders. As an example, the canon on marriage states "The matrimonial covenant, by which a man and a woman establish between themselves a partnership of the whole of life and which is ordered by its nature to the good of the spouses and the procreation and education of offspring, has been raised by Christ the Lord to the dignity of a sacrament between the baptized."

We then study the original Latin words from this canon. For instance, the word covenant in Latin is the word 'foedus', which originates from the word 'faith' or 'fidelity'. Hence, when a couple come together in the sacrament of matrimony, they do so as an act of faith - both as an act of faith in the one whom they are marrying and a faithful trusting in God's lifelong presence in their union.

The professor (forgot) but he intended to bring into class two large die (dice) to illustrate a further point. The word partnership in the above quote, is 'consortium' in Latin. And the word 'sors' (found in the middle of the word 'con-sortium') in Latin means 'lot', 'chance' or 'fate'. Thus, the word partnership literally refers to two people throwing their lots together for life - hoping it will work :)

So marriage is vocation where two people place in a very serious manner their 'foedus' in each another and God for a life-long 'consortium', recognizing God's action lifting them up as a sign of Christ and His Church.

Please pray for me in my finals coming next week! I will be back July 29th. Looking forward to seeing you all when I return!

May St. John the Baptist pray for us and bless us.
