#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: It is great being back! It was such a pleasure to greet everyone last weekend following our Masses.

Canon Law covers many different aspects of the church. However, one area of unique importance is parish membership. In America we typically think of parish registration as the means by which we join a parish. But this is not considered in the law of the church. The canons of the universal church connect domicile to church membership. A person acquires canonical domicile by living in a place with the intention of remaining there indefinitely, or by actually residing there for five years. A quasi-domicile is similar, but requires only the intention of remaining or actual residence for at least three months. Your domicile is the location of your "true, permanent home," the place you intend to return to after any absences. A person can have more than one domicile. For instance, a student in college retains domicile where they grew up and acquires a new domicile where they study. The same occurs when a person joins the military. Similarly, a person who spends several months wintering in the south can in effect have two different domiciles.

Parish registration is a non-canonical custom, common in places like our country. It serves practical purposes for parish administration, such as record keeping and communication with parishioners. Registration enables the parish to better know and minister to its community. It facilitates things like receiving sacraments and religious education.

You can attend Mass and be involved in a parish other than your domicile, but your canonical parish membership is generally determined by where you live. Therefore, in situations like marriage the church treats your territorial parish or diocese as your canonical membership and requests for marriage will always flow from the pastor or bishop where you live.

In essence, domicile is about your official, geographically defined parish based on where you reside with the intention of staying, while parish registration is a practical act of formally associating with a specific parish community. While your domicile automatically determines your canonical parish, registration allows you to actively participate and engage with the parish of your choice, even if it's not the one directly tied to your domicile.

I hope this discussion provides some clarity to a concept used by the church that is often misunderstood.
