Mass of Hope and Healing Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman: Bishop Gerard Battersby will celebrate a Mass of Hope and Healing on Tuesday, September 23rd at 6:30pm at the Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman. This Mass will be offered for anyone grieving the loss of children through miscarriage, ectopic pregnancy, abortion, stillbirth, accident or infant death. A book of remembrance will be available before and after Mass for those who would like to inscribe the name(s) of their child(ren). Votive candles will be given to families before Mass in remembrance of each child. Candles will be lit and carried forward by family members, just before the entrance procession, and placed before the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. After Mass, refreshments will be served along with display of resources and books in the Gathering Space. Volunteers with name tags will be present to offer assistance, support, and comfort.

St. John the Baptist Parish is the grateful recipient of a grant from the Diocese of La Crosse Bishop's Education Endowment Trust. The new playground at St John's Primary school looks great and I thank all of the benefactors who have already contributed. Our bishop has granted us the ability to fundraise up to \$270,000 for the playground. This means that monies raised will not be counted towards our future annual appeal and quota assessments. So in essence donations toward this playground project is a very good way to give to the parish. So far we have raised a total of \$139,010. We are permitted to continue to raise \$130,990 in additional funds and can receive these funds at any time before June 30, 2026. Through other parish accounts we have already paid all the bills for the playground; however, since we have been granted permission to raise a total of \$270,000 and the additional funds raised won't be used in our assessment calculations, please consider donating towards the playground as a good way to assist our parish.

From Reverend Anbalagan Shanmugam

Dear Loving Parishioners,

I belong to the Catholic Diocese of Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India and at present I am serving for the Diocese of La Crosse at Sacred Heart, Spring Valley, Sacred Heart, Elmwood and St. Luke's, Boyceville.

The Catholic Diocese of Vellore was started by Salesians in the year 1952. Further, in 1969, a few parishes from the Archdiocese of Pondicherry-Cuddalore were attached to this Diocese. It comprises of two civil districts namely Vellore and Tiruvannamalai. There are 89 parishes having a Catholic population of 200,000 people with 185 priests serving in my Diocese. Our Diocese is a Mission Diocese and almost 95% of the Catholics are belonging to the lower caste (Untouchable Communities). India is cursed by the caste system. We have approximately 3000 caste and 25,000 subcaste. In that last layer of the caste system people are called untouchables. Everything in India runs according to their caste. The lower caste people are denied of their human rights, social rights and political rights. They are denied an education, employment and social dignity. In the Catholic Church the caste system is deeply rooted. Among the 19 Dioceses and three Archdioceses in the state of TamilNadu only two bishops are from this untouchable community and there are no Archbishops.

The Diocese of Vellore is a Mission Diocese where the children are denied an education and their basic human rights so the Diocese is making an appeal to you to help our children to get their education. The Catholics are a minority in India. The present government and the majority of the people are Hindu and because of this many churches were demolished. Recently, two Catholic nuns were arrested by Hindu fanatics. Real persecution is going on in India. The Diocese of Vellore Priests have 150 year old buildings to live in. These buildings have lots of leakages and we don't know when they will fall down. Therefore, our Diocese believes that only through education can we bring transformation. Education can bring massive changes in the society and in their lives. In the name of the Catholic Diocese of Vellore we make an appeal to you to help our children's education. You are invited to light the life of a child!!
