
Mass on Monday, September 1st (Labor Day) will be at 8:00am and the parish office will be closed. Have a safe and enjoyable Labor Day!

The new playground at St John's Primary school looks great and I thank all of the benefactors who have already contributed. Our bishop has granted us the ability to fundraise up to \$270,000 for the playground. This means that monies raised will not be counted towards our future annual appeal and quota assessments. So in essence donations toward this playground project is a very good way to give to the parish. So far we have raised a total of \$139,010. We are permitted to continue to raise \$130,990 in additional funds and can receive these funds at any time before June 30, 2026. Through other parish accounts we have already paid all the bills for the playground; however, since we have been granted permission to raise a total of \$270,000 and the additional funds raised won't be used in our assessment calculations, please consider donating towards the playground as a good way to assist our parish. FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: This weekend we welcome Fr. Anbu to our parish who will be speaking about the needs of the Diocese of Vellore in India. The missions are a key part of our faith. At the end of the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus urges us "to make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Our faith is always outward looking. We are always engaged in making sacrifices so that the faith may be seeded both near and far.

It is interesting to note how many times 'washing' occurs in liturgy. Our Jewish ancestors incorporated many ritualized washings in their daily life such as 'the purification of cups and jugs and kettles and beds." (Mk 7:4) As Catholics we do many of the same ritual acts at Mass. Can you think of some? For instance, at Mass the priest purifies his hands when the servers bring him water and a bowl. Following, Holy Communion the priest often purifies his hands in the ablution cup, the small bowl next to the tabernacle. An important washing occurs on Holy Thursday with the washing of the feet and the most important washing occurs during the baptism of an individual. Why all this washing? Yes, it is very good to be sanitary and clean; however, the real reason for ritualized washing is much deeper.

The law of the church guiding the celebration of the sacraments is referred to as the 'Sanctifying function of the Church.' The use of the word sanctifying is akin to the action of washing. The mission of the church is to separate us from sin. This separation from sin is a sanctifying action of the church and it is visibly seen in the washing of water. This washing, whether physical as in Baptism or spiritual as in the sacrament of Confession, detaches us from sin. A life of prayer and a daily invitation of Christ into one's life further separates (washes) one from sin. All of this centers your life upon Christ.

The salvation of Christ is meant for the whole world. This is accomplished by the sanctifying function of the church - symbolized by the washings and purifications of our liturgy - visible signs made efficacious through the sacraments.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us and bless us.
