FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: October is the Month of the Rosary. We all know in a general way the importance of the Rosary. However, why should you pray the Rosary? Are you praying the Rosary now? Do you pray the Rosary every day?

I was blessed to grow up praying the Rosary with my family. I personally began a daily recitation of the Rosary back in 2007 and have maintained this practice ever since. I can truly say the moment I began praying the Rosary on a daily basis was a watershed turning point in my life. I was always intentional in trying to follow God, but not until I began to pray the Rosary on a daily basis did my life with God develop a personal life-giving quality.

1 Timothy 2:5 says, "There is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus." Many hear this passage and believe that we can only pray to Jesus. 


