FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: I have been pastor here at St. John the Baptist now for a little over three years. This past Sunday as I was celebrating Mass I was just thinking about every detail of our church and how I know the hand of almost every parishioner who has touched and cared for each of the small yet significant parts of our church. Much like the body of Christ where St. Paul highlights the importance of every part of the body. The ear and the nose cannot say, "I am not an eye I do not belong to the body," (1 Cor 12). We are all one in Christ, blessing and serving one another.

I know the hands of the individual who has added the extra padding to all the chairs, the individual who helped stabilize the confessional kneeler so that it does not rock so much, the individuals who set every candle in the church, the persons who put up every flower and decoration, the individual who cleans the carpets between Masses, the person who adds new grout to the sanctuary floor, the helper who put in extra coat racks for the ushers, the individuals who lock and unlock the church, the person who organizes every book in the pews. I have come to know the people who visit our homebound, the ones who assist a grieving family in the time of death, the children who come with their families to adoration, the individuals seeking the blessing of their love in marriage, the persons preparing food for our children and for funerals, the catechizing of our youth and the continuing formation of our adults.

Though I have come to know so much, I also know so little. But the Lord knows all. He meets you here in this parish and in any parish where the sacraments, the real presence of Jesus is to be found.

It has been now a few weeks since Fr. Mlsna was asked to take on the responsibility of Parochial Administrator at St. Patrick's in Mauston. With his absence, I reluctantly had to make several weekday Mass time changes. The Masses on Monday through Thursday will begin at 6:45am. This will allow me time to login to my Canon Law classes which begin at 7:30pm. Confessions will be available Monday through Thursday beginning at 6:15am until just before Mass begins. Confessions are also available after the 8:00am Saturday Mass and on the third Friday of the month beginning at 6:00pm.

Because my classes in January will be on Mondays and Wednesdays, Fridays seem to be the best option for my day off going forward. This will allow those who wish to attend Mass every day the continued option of doing so by attending Sacred Heart at 8am or one of the other local parishes in our Deanery. We will continue to offer First Friday Mass here at St. John the Baptist; however, Mass will be cancelled on the other Fridays. On Fridays St. John the Baptist will be opened at 6am as usual for anyone who would like to spend time in prayer before work. If you have a Mass intention scheduled for a Friday, it will be said in a private Mass by me unless you call the parish office and request a change.
