#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners: As we continue this month of November we continue to recall the many saints of our church. The saints are our intercessors and friends. They now stand face to face with God in adoration. When we pray for the intercession of a saint, the saint has a particular efficacy in bringing our prayers to Jesus who is the 'one mediator between God and the human race.' (1 Tim 2:5)

Our church here at St. John the Baptist is blessed with some beautiful statues of the saints. These statues allow us to venerate a saint in a more visual way. As Catholics we do not worship a saint or their statue. Rather in seeing a statue we are moved to think about the saint and to ask for their intercession.

When I have a Baptism, myself and the family pray a short litany of the saints. Each of the saints listed have statues in our sanctuary: the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph, St. John the Baptist, St. Peter and St. Paul. The presence of the statues of each of these saints makes physically visible their already true presence at every Baptism.

Outside of our church we have the beautiful statues of St. Bernadette and Mother Mary. About a year ago we were able to erect these two statues in the space between the garage and the church. These two statues are such a blessing for me as I see them every time I enter the church. I am so grateful to the parishioners who with such great care erected and restored these statues.

Not only do these two statues remind me of the incredible grace of Our Lady of Lourdes and the miraculous events surrounding this event in France in 1858. However, it also reconnects me with the Sisters of the Sorrowful Mother who so much blessed our community for so many years. These statues indeed were first erected at a grotto at our hospital, when it was formerly a Catholic hospital dedicated to St. Joseph. When I see these two beautifully restored statues, I give thanks to the many religious who served our community so faithfully for so many years. It also gives me hope for the future and spurs me to pray for new vocations to the religious and consecrated life.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.
