FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners of St John the Baptist!

As we approach Christmas and the Nativity of Our Lord, I reflect on the many Baptisms celebrated and how each are such special moments for our families. Few things bring more joy than Baptisms. The joy and hope offered to us by every newborn, however, is only a glimpse of the supernatural wonders that occur during each Baptism.

Every child, upon conception, is already made in God's image and likeness. At Baptism a child is gifted with something more, something so unspeakably incredible, that if we did not have faith we would never believe is true. At each Baptism a child becomes adopted as a son or daughter of God, a true adoption into the life of our Lord occurs. Thus, everything that God has is now the child's by inheritance. It is the parent's mission then to share the faith with the child so that which was seeded at Baptism matures into a living faith. There is no greater gift that a parent can give to a child, than the gift of Baptism.

One of the unique rites of Baptism comes near the end of the celebration. This part of the rite is called the Ephphatha prayer and it is when the celebrant touches the ears and the mouth of the baby being baptized, praying that the child will be able to hear the word of God and proclaim His holy word. This rite is derived from the Gospel of Mark, where Jesus says "Ephphatha!" ("Be opened!") to a man who was deaf and mute. As the priest or deacon touches the ears and the mouth of the child being baptized with his thumb, the celebrant then recites the prayer, "The Lord Jesus made the deaf hear and the mute speak. May He soon touch your ears to receive His word, and your mouth to proclaim His faith, to the praise and glory of God the Father". This gesture symbolizes the spiritual opening of the person to God's word, a transformation from being unable to hear and speak God's truth to being able to receive it and share it.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.


